The Barnet (Free Parking Places, Loading Places, Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No.11) Order 2016

Coming into operation: 25th January 2016

The Council of the London Borough of Barnet, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. <u>Citation and commencement</u>

1.1 This Order shall come into operation on 25th January 2016 and may be cited as The Barnet (Free Parking Places, Loading Places, Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No.11) Order 2016

2. <u>Interpretation</u>

- 2.1 In this Order "the Order of 2014" means The Barnet (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2014(b)
- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

Substitution of Map Tiles

- 3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2014 shall have effect as though for the map tile attached to that Order and specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order, there were substituted the map tile attached to this Order and specified in relation thereto in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3.2 The substitution of any map tile referred to in Article 3.1 of this Order will have the effect of revoking any provision provided or designated by a previous version of that map tile and not incorporated into the latest version.

This Order makes changes to the charged-for, on-street parking provisions/restrictions in the London Borough of Barnet at certain locations by replacing and adding versions of certain map tiles to the Order of 2014.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The above Orders relate to Waiting Restrictions as detailed below.

Waiting Restrictions

In order to provide improved loading opportunity for local businesses outside of the morning peak period when existing load restrictions are in operation, the general effect of the Orders will be to amend the parking layout as follows:

1. Upgrade existing lengths of 7am to 7pm Monday to Saturday and 7am to 10am Monday to Friday waiting restrictions outside nos. 400a to 406 Finchley Road NW2 to 'At any time' waiting restrictions;

2. Remove 8 metres of existing 'Payment Parking' bay outside nos. 400a to 402 Finchley

Road NW2.

In order to compensate for the loss of parking outlined in 2 above and to improve parking opportunity for local shoppers, the Orders will also convert the existing loading bay on Devonshire Place NW2 to a 'Payment Parking' bay operational between 9am and 5.30pm Monday to Friday with the following tariff:

Up to 30 minutes £1.00 Up to 1 hour £2.00 Up to 90 minutes £3.00

In order to deter obstructive parking, improve sightlines and safety, the Free Order will also upgrade existing lengths of 7am to 7pm Monday to Saturday waiting restrictions around the junction of Finchley Road NW2 and Devonshire Place NW2 to 'At any time' waiting restrictions.
