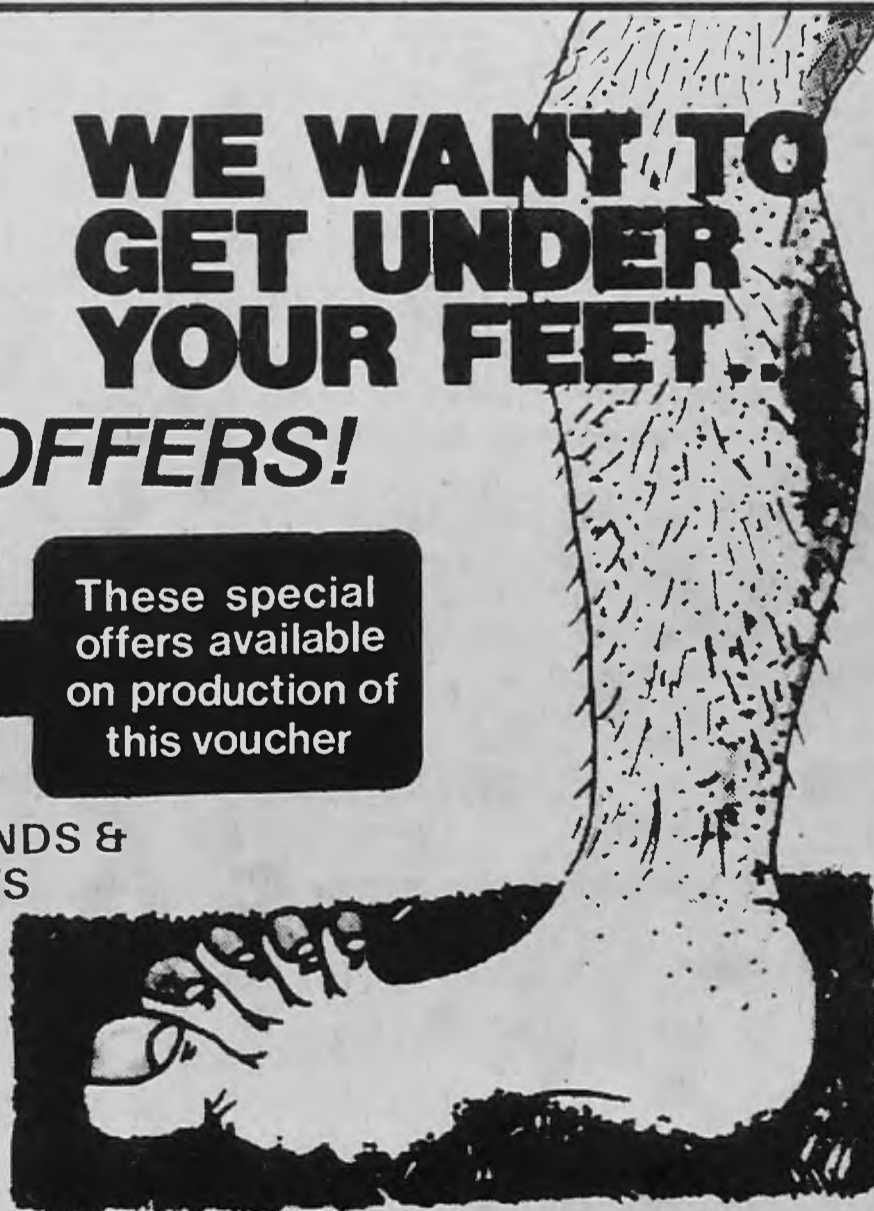

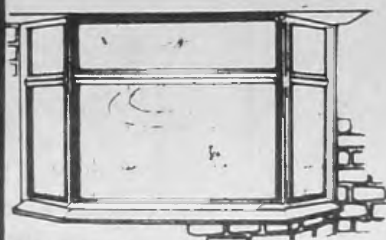

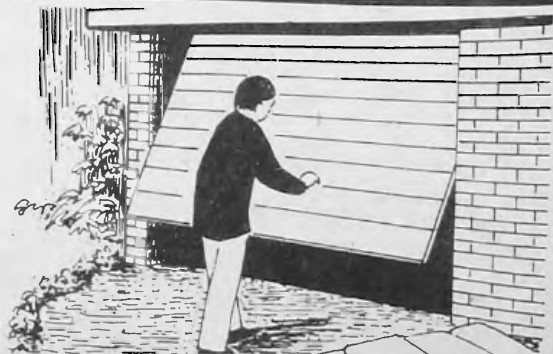

SATURDAY, JUNE 14, 2.30 pm, starting from the ORANGE TREE public house on TOTTERIDGE COMMON. These are the details you need to join in an afternoon ramble along part of the network of country footpaths recently improved in the Totteridge area. The ramble is being organised as part of Footpath Heritage '80, a week of national promotion and improvement of the country's footpath network.

As a contribution to this, Barnet Council, in conjunction with the Countryside Commission, has undertaken a project to improve a network of paths in and around Totteridge. The details of the paths are included in a free pamphlet obtainable from Council offices and public libraries which sets out several rambles around the paths with different lengths, depending on your energy.

Improvements have been made to stiles and gates, the walking surface has been made easier and a trail of colour coded marking has been placed. There is no intention to 'municipalise' our countryside.

Credit for the work done must go to an experimental project whereby Barnet Council, together with other local authorities and the Countryside Commission, has contributed towards a small team of staff undertaking similar projects in the Green Belt of Barnet and South Herts. This team is negotiating, designing and implementing various projects in the Green Belt and

helping to improve access and increase an awareness of the need for sound Countryside Management.

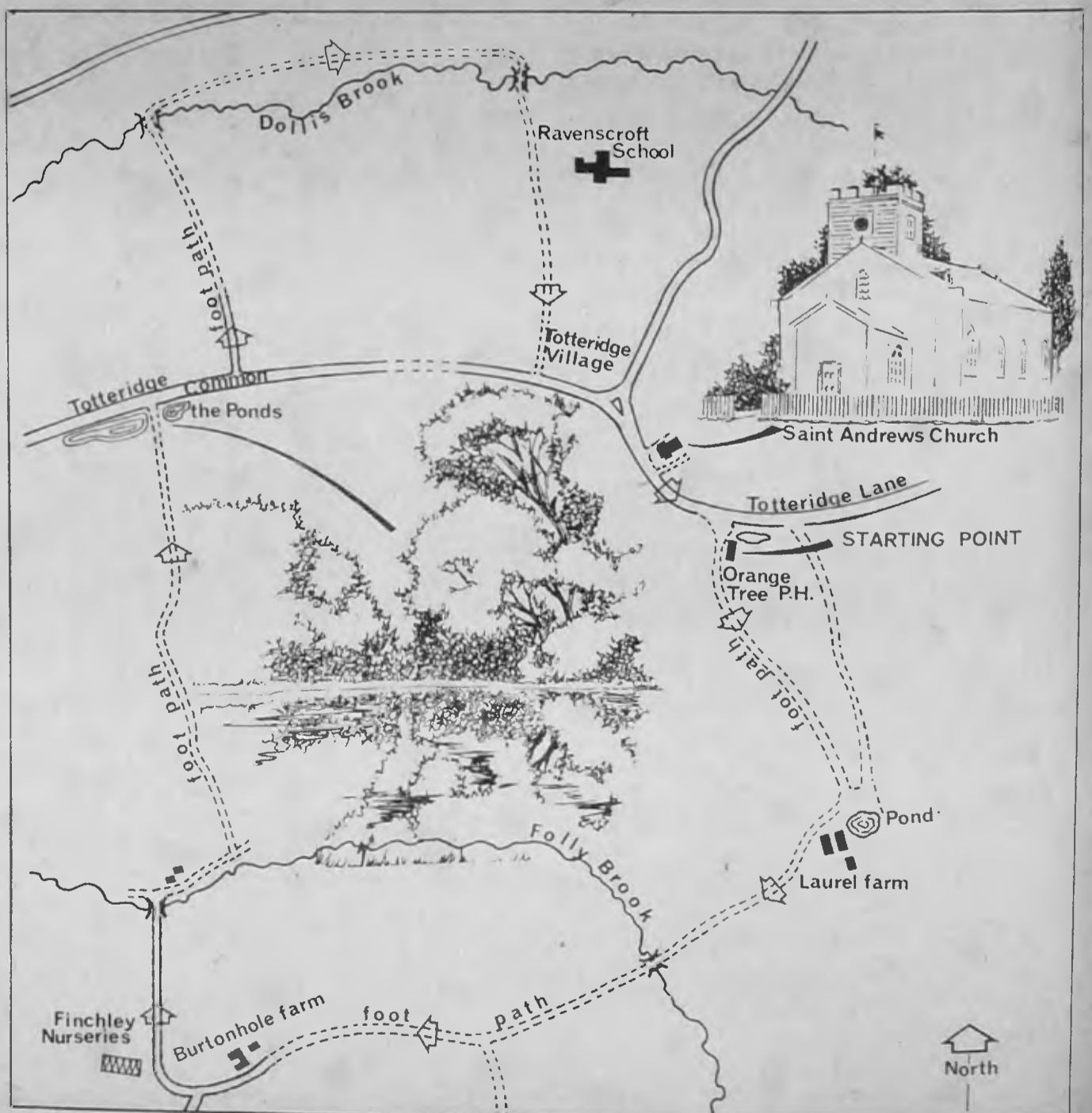
Another example of their work can be seen in Arkley Lane where the project team began clearance and restoration so that a lane satisfactory for horse riders and pedestrians could be restored. Following their lead the Council has now continued the improvement through to the A1 where the Department of Transport has been asked to approve the re-siting of the horse crossing signs.

Following consultation with local residents, the team has also constructed an adventure playground at Broadfields Estate, Edgware, in an attempt to reduce trespass on adjoining farmland. The fencing and clearance to enhance Woodridge Nature Reserve in Woodside Park has been completed and increased use by local schools is now planned.

Following this example and with the assistance of Central Government grant aid, the Council is itself carrying out several improvements to the Green Belt. A substantial programme of restoration work to the King George V fields off Barnet Lane is taking place. Hedges are to be restored, ditches cleared and trees attended to as necessary. A horse ride across the Dollis Valley between Mays Lane and Grange Avenue is being provided and other projects will be implemented as funds become available.

The Totteridge footpath system, shown below, is the first step in making the Barnet countryside more accessible to all.

Barnet is rich in community spirit says our new Mayor

*'I promise that I
Will do my duty to God
and the Queen,
To the Council,
And the Citizens of the
London Borough of Barnet.'*

WITH THIS MODIFIED version of the Guide Movement's promise the new Mayor of Barnet, Councillor Mrs. Edna James, took up office as the first Citizen of the Borough.

The occasion was the Annual Meeting of the Council on Tuesday, May 13, held in the Council Chamber at the Town Hall, Hendon.

As is traditional, it was an evening of ceremony. The retiring Mayor, Councillor Mrs. Rita Levy, wearing the chain of office for the last time, opened the meeting, inviting her chaplain, the Rev. Saul Amias, to say prayers.

Then came the election of the new Mayor who was proposed by Councillor Leslie Sussman and seconded by Councillor Mrs. Barbara Langstone.

Both paid tribute to Mrs. James' sense of duty and willingness to accept responsibility. Councillor Sussman said: 'She has firm convictions on certain matters but she always understands and respects the opinions of others.' Mrs. Langstone referred to Mrs. James' involvement in service to the community.

The Council then voted unanimously to elect Mrs. James as Mayor and she entered the Council Chamber wearing the scarlet robes of office and preceded by the twin maces of the former Boroughs of Finchley and Hendon.

The chain of office was placed about her shoulders and with the Town Clerk, Mr. Michael Bennett, standing beside her, she took the oath of service to the borough.

Then followed the appointment of her daughter, Helen, as Mayoress, of the Deputy Mayor and Mayoress, Councillor and Mrs. Victor Lyon; and finally of the Mayor's chaplain, the Rev. Christopher Bishop, Minister of East Finchley Methodist Church.

In a message to the citizens of the borough through Civic News, the Mayor said:

'I feel it is a very great honour to take on this office as Mayor of Barnet, and I do so in a spirit of service to its people.'

'This is not an easy period in our borough's history. The country as a whole is facing a harsh economic situation and we in Barnet will inevitably feel the results of financial pressures.'

'As a Council we are sometimes divided in our opinions as to what should or should not be done, what savings

should or should not be made. But I can assure you that we all try to do what we feel is best, within our powers, for this borough of which we have every reason to be proud.'

'Under this economic climate I know we shall be relying as heavily as ever on the voluntary efforts of local groups, clubs and societies, to add to the quality of local life, particularly for those who through age or disability are less able to cope with the pressure of life today.'

'I have heard it said Barnet is a rich

borough. Yes we are rich in the community spirit and sense of service and involvement shown by local voluntary organisations.

'As Chairman of the General Purposes Committee in recent years I have seen a great deal of the work of many community groups and have been impressed by their initiative and commitment.

'During this past year I have admired the untiring work and service undertaken by the past Mayor, Councillor Mrs. Rita Levy. She has set us all an example in the way she encouraged our local voluntary movements.

'I have always been very interested in youth movements and my work at Finchley Memorial Hospital has brought me into contact with a group of both professional and voluntary workers who are dedicated to the service of the community.

'I look forward to my year of service as your Mayor and I hope that we, the residents and councillors of this borough, will work together to make Barnet an even better place in which to live.'

MAYOR'S APPEAL AIDS DISABLED RIDERS

THE MAYOR OF BARNET, Councillor Mrs. Edna James, has chosen Trigger Riding Group for the Disabled as the subject of her Mayor's Appeal.

She announced her choice at the reception following the Council's Annual Meeting and Mayor Making. Amid applause and cries of 'Hear hear' and 'Well done' she said she had selected the Trigger project because it was entirely manned by volunteers and was a very local organisation, with members of local day centres and training centres for the handicapped and disabled having riding lessons during the week and local disabled children taking part at the weekends.

The objective of the appeal is to provide stabling and a large tack room which can be used for social gatherings.

Trigger Riding Group for the Disabled is at present based at Burtonhole Lane stables but is hoping to move to new quarters. Disabled children and adults are able to ride on ponies selected for their gentle and steady temperament, and volunteer able-bodied riders act as escorts to make sure

the disabled riders are safe and comfortable.

The scheme at first was simply to offer handicapped people a chance to enjoy an outdoor pursuit normally denied to them. But it has also been found that riding helps build self-confidence and a genuine bond of friendship is established between the riders and the volunteer helpers.

The Mayoress, Helen James, herself a keen rider, is writing to all schools and riding establishments hoping that they will organise events in aid of the appeal. In her letter she says:

'I think it must be a little like a fairy story when your wheelchair turns into a pony for an hour: A Cinderella story which I am hoping that you will help us to make come true.'

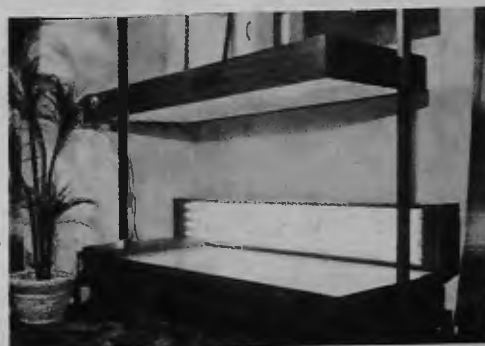

CHAMPAGNE LAUNCH FOR ROUTE 205

GRAHAME PARK has a new bus route. On Saturday, May 17, the 205 which links Mill Hill Broadway with the Edgware Road, Colindale, was given a champagne launch by the Hendon North London Transport Action Committee.

This new bus runs at half-hourly intervals from Mill Hill Broadway Bus Station through Grahame Park Way via Corner Mead to the RAF Museum, and then runs down Colindale Avenue to the Underground Station, and through to Annesley Avenue and the Edgware Road, stopping near the Technical College.

There is a 10p flat rate fare and the first bus leaves Mill Hill Broadway at 07.01, and the last bus at 21.01. The Saturday service runs from 09.01 to 16.00 and there is no Sunday service.

The Council's Public Works Committee, Grahame Park Residents' Association, Mr. Bryan Cassidy, GLC member for Hendon North, and the Action Committee have all been urging London Transport to improve the services through Grahame Park for three years, so when the first 205 set off from

Edgware Bus Station a group of enthusiastic residents were there to give it a send-off.

Mr. Cassidy broached a bottle of champagne and among those who drank to the 'good health' of the route were Councillor Mrs. Dot Benson, Mr. Max Brooker, chairman of Grahame Park Residents' Association, Mr. Peter Wharton, of the Action Committee, and Mr. Jim Oliver, manager of Watling District for London Transport.

News of the new service had percolated through the estate via the Residents' Newsletter, and there were several people waiting at the stops along the way.

'We are really pleased to have this new service,' Max Brooker said. 'I hope people will make good use of it so that London Transport will keep it going and perhaps they will even extend it through to Hendon and Edgware. People in the northern half of Grahame Park have felt very cut off from public transport services and there are many older people on the estate so I believe the service should be well used once it gets known.'

New athletics competition

THE FINAL of a new national inter-schools athletics cup competition is being staged on July 17 at Barnet Copthall Stadium, off Great North Way, Hendon, and Page Street, Mill Hill, by the English Schools' Athletic Association with special sponsorship by the National Dairy Council.

One of the objects of the competition is to enable all secondary schools, whatever their size, to compete on a team basis by using points scoring tables to progress through local and regional lines to a national final.

In 1979 a pilot scheme was run in

Southern Counties and a Barnet school, Moat Mount, won the girls' final.

Barnet Copthall Stadium was used for the regional round in 1979 and the facilities were so ideal that the organisers asked for the first national final to be staged there.

On Thursday afternoon, July 17, some 450 athletes in 32 teams from all parts of England will take part in an intensive programme of events to discover the top athletics schools in the country.

The event is being organised by the Barnet Schools' Athletics Association in conjunction with the ESAA.

GREAT HOLIDAY PLAYAWAY

A BOROUGH-WIDE programme of summer play schemes and children's entertainments is being organised throughout Barnet to help counter school holiday boredom and assist parents who have to be out at work all day.

The play schemes will run between July 28 and August 22, and this year there has been an increase in the number of centres promoted by local community groups supported by the Council. It means there is a wide variety of sport and recreational activity within easy reach of most residents.

In recent years there has been a steady development in the number and variety of opportunities for children during school holidays — particularly the long summer holiday.

In the Borough of Barnet the holiday play schemes are administered by the Borough's Education Department working closely with the Social Services Directorate. Most of the centres are for children aged between five and 12 years.

The Education Department are running three self-financing open-to-all centres at Ashmole School, Southgate; Broadfields School, Edgware; and Summerside School, North Finchley. There is a fee of £10 a week — but a word of warning. These schemes have proved very popular in past years and are usually over-subscribed.

Social Services are organising a series of supervised play centres for which they are responsible for all enrolments.

The schemes, promoted by local

community groups, are also borough-wide this year with play leaders assisted by voluntary helpers.

In addition to the play schemes the local sports centres at Grahame Park, Queen Elizabeth's Girls' and Ashmole schools will be running special holiday courses.

Road Safety Cycling courses are being organised for children over 10 years old, and details of these can be obtained from the Road Safety Section, tel. 349 9121.

For all other holiday play scheme details contact the Education Department at Friern Barnet Town Hall, telephone 368 1255 and ask for Holiday Play Scheme information.

Cycling menace on pavements

I see in the Barnet Civic News for April that the Council is to take action against drivers who park their vehicles on pavements and that it intends to put up notices as a preliminary measure.

Could you not also put up notices prohibiting cycling on the pavements, which is a very real threat in the Garden Suburb, particularly during school holidays, but at other times as well.

The article in the Civic News states that pedestrians have a right to be able to walk in safety on the pavements, as indeed they have, but cyclists are a dangerous threat to that safety — particularly to blind and disabled people, just as are cars parked on pavements.

These youngsters and teenagers and even an occasional adult, ride along full pelt as though the pavements were their own, made just for them. Unfortunately there is never a policeman on duty. They cycle along very fast heedless of anyone

who might be walking or standing on the pavements, coming close alongside one from behind, with no sound and with no warning whatever, and often just skim one's elbows.

It is quite alarming. I have had quite a few narrow shaves myself and a woman was knocked over on the pavement in the Market Place a few months ago by one of these offenders and her collarbone was broken. A man was also knocked over by a cyclist on the pavement in Golders Green, while in conversation with another man.

I have twice contacted the police in Golders Green, who were sympathetic, but who seemed to have no powers to do anything.

I understand that cycling on the pavements is illegal.

I also understand that young children cannot be prosecuted.

If warning notices were put up, however, for children and parents to see, and defied, maybe *parents* could be prosecuted.

Surely there is something which can be done.

TWO UP ONE TO GO

WITH LESS THAN a week to run for the 1979/80 Mayor's Appeal, Councillor Mrs Rita Levy, ending her year as Mayor of Barnet, announced a third target for the Fund.

The first, and originally the only target, was an £8,000 holiday home for families with a member suffering from multiple sclerosis. Sited at Sandford Park, near Poole in Dorset, it was opened at Easter and is well booked up for this season.

The second, added when funds began to flow in at a higher level than expected, was a £14,000 motorised caravan specially adapted so that people in wheelchairs can go on touring holidays with their families. This was symbolically handed over on May 8 and will be in full use next year.

The third, added as the fund passed the second zone of £22,000, is a minibus which will be administered by John Grooms Association for the Disabled to service the disabled holidays scheme.

This third target was announced at the handover of the motorised caravan, a ceremony held at John Grooms Edgware estate. John Grooms

will be administering both the holiday projects, giving priority in the bookings to Barnet families with a disabled member.

The motorised caravan on show was not the actual van which the Fund has purchased, but a similar model with a tail lift to take wheelchairs. The Barnet caravan will have a toilet and shower compartment adapted for disabled users and will be able to sleep four to five people.

It is at present having the modifications fitted and is due for delivery towards the end of this summer.

Among those attending the ceremony were Frank Willows, chairman of John Grooms Association; Charles Moore, director; Lady Joan Laing, founder of the Friends of John Grooms; and Councillor Mrs. Ena Summers, chairman of the Appeal Committee with her daughter-in-law Vivien, appeals secretary.

The Mayor thanked them all for the work they had put into making the appeal a record-breaking success. It had already passed the £25,000 mark.

She repeated her thanks at the Town Hall, Hendon, that evening, when she entertained a group of people who had helped

her in the appeal.

At the reception a new film showing the work of John Grooms was given its Barnet première. This film, 'It happened to Lucina', tells the story of a young civil servant who lost the use of her legs in a car accident. Her determination to rebuild her life, even though

confined to a wheelchair is told, emphasising two of the main factors which allowed her to achieve her ambition: her employers, the Foreign Office, held her job open for her and Grooms provided a flat specially built for a disabled tenant.

This film was made by Hamer Productions, a Barnet company.

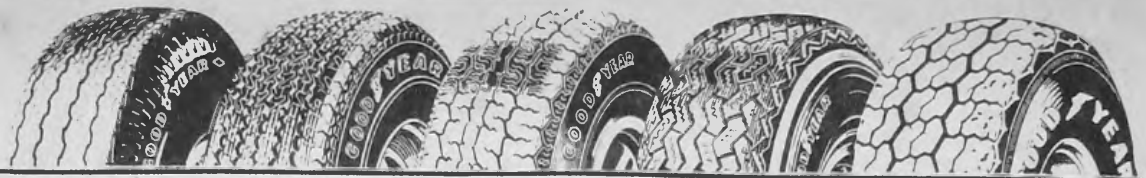

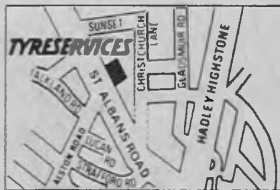

EAST BARNET

East Barnet Ward is mainly a residential area, sandwiched between Hadley Common to the North and Oak Hill Park to the South with Pymmes Brook meandering through its centre. There are several small shopping parades and the housing ranges from large residences to Victorian cottages and modern blocks of flats.



COUNCILLOR E. T. 'BOB' DANKS is very well known in the commercial life of the borough for his work with local trades. He is the liaison officer between the Council and the Borough of Barnet Joint Chambers of Commerce and is president of East Barnet Chamber.

Born in South London he came to East Barnet in the 1930s, and feels a strong link with the community he represents. He was elected to Barnet Council in 1978 and serves on the Public Works, Allotments, and Town Planning and Research Committees, is Vice-chairman of the Northern Division Planning Sub-Committee, and a member of Barnet and District Post Office Advisory Committee.

Before retiring he worked as installation manager for a national organisation. This brought him into contact with local authorities and industry all over England. He still has an active business involvement with the bakery and confectionery trade.

He is a Governor of Ashmole, Southaw and Monken Hadley C. of E. Schools and a manager of a local group of primary schools. He also takes great interest in the welfare of the elderly.

He is keen to encourage youth and through his initiative in liaising between Barnet Copthall Swimming Club and the Chambers of Commerce he was able to rally sponsorship for the championship events which take place during Barnet Sports Gala weekend, and several fine trophies were contributed.

Although he finds that his Council and Chamber of Commerce activities take up most of his spare time he still manages to enjoy his own recreations of horse riding and gardening.



COUNCILLOR MISS OLWEN EVANS comes from a family traditionally active in local government. Her grandfather was a councillor on the former Southwark Borough Council, and her cousin is Leader of Uttlesford Council in Essex.

She came into local government from a desire to make an active contribution at local level, and her particular interest is education. She is vice-chairman of the Libraries and Arts Committee and a member of the Education Committee and the Schools and Special Services sub-committee. Olwen is also a Governor of Ashmole and East Barnet Schools, being a former pupil of the latter, and is vice-chairman of the Managers of a group of primary schools.

She also serves on Development and Estates Committee and is a member of the newly formed Building Resources Sub-Committee.

'As you can see, since my election to the Council two years ago, life is very full and there is little time for any other interest,' she said. 'Just reading the paper work takes many hours, and there are meetings to attend, visits to make and letters and calls from the ward residents to attend to. But I still manage to enjoy music — that's my Welsh ancestry — and I undertake all the decorating in my own home.'

After an early career in law publishing she studied for three evenings a week at the City of London College to qualify as a Company Secretary, but today she spends more time in accountancy, visiting companies on short assignments when a special need arises.



COUNCILLOR JOHN PERRY, who is 29, has taken on the vice-chairmanship of the Housing Committee. He was elected to the Council in 1978 and his strong interest in people and welfare has also led him to membership of the Social Services Committee.

He is an executive committee member of the Community Relations Council and the Voluntary Service Council, and takes an active interest in Church Farm and Pymmes Youth Clubs. He is also a Governor of Southaw, Queen Elizabeth's Schools and Finchley Catholic High, and a manager of St. Catherine's School, Barnet.

He first became interested in politics when living in Haringey where he worked closely with Tory councillors and with the Hornsey MP, Hugh Rossi. He has held posts at national and regional level in the Tory party and is the author of a number of political publications. He has appeared on both British and American television, discussing Community Relations, an area in which he is greatly concerned.

John feels his Council work goes hand in hand with his legal career. In both fields he is helping people cope with problems. He feels it important that the value of local voluntary organisations should be recognised and that the Council should maintain all the financial support that it can manage.

'Volunteers and volunteering must never be seen as a cheap substitute for state and local authority support,' he says.

He is a keen rugby player and at present is a disappointed Arsenal fan: 'Roll on next season, we'll be even better then,' he said.



DABB hands for the disabled

ANYONE WHO IS disabled or whose family includes a disabled member knows the problems of finding the right source for help and discovering the right forms to fill in.

Society today is very aware of the needs of the disabled and is geared to encourage them to be independent and play their full part in the community. There are many grants, aids and services available. Some come through the Area Health Authority, some from the Department of Health and Social Security at a national level, some from the Council's Social Services Department, and some through such organisations as the Red Cross.

Finding a way through the maze can be bewildering, so having a voluntary organisation which has developed a special expertise in this area is invaluable. This is one of the important contributions that DABB — the Disablement Association in the Borough of Barnet — is making to community life.

Caring, sharing and daring — its organisers and members offer advice and help in problems of every kind experienced by those who are handicapped — from pensions to

practical aids; from motorbility leasing to mobility allowances; from holidays to housing.

It is not all that easy to find DABB's offices, which are in an annexe at the back of East Barnet Town Hall in Station Road, New Barnet. But once there, a gold mine of information can be tapped and the welcoming atmosphere makes everyone feel at home.

Perhaps because of the limited mobility of many who use DABB's services the telephone is the main link between the office and its clients.

In a year they receive more than 2,000 enquiries from disabled people and in addition there are many calls from voluntary organisations.

Activity

So much is happening. DABB helps to run a summer holiday play scheme for handicapped children in association with the Barnet Society and the Social Services. This is in August at Outlook House.

There are two stroke clubs, one in East Barnet Health Centre, run by Mrs. Penny Learmonth, and one at Grahame Park Health Centre, run by Mrs. Veronica Noah.

Successful public meetings have been held to highlight the problems of the deaf, blind and partially sighted and the education of handicapped children.

DABB has been in touch with a leading oil company to try and get better facilities for disabled drivers at self-service petrol stations, and they are in regular contact with the Borough Engineer and Surveyor's Department and the Planning Department over the ramping of pavements and new planning developments, as well as the Post Master General with a view to obtaining better access to Post Offices throughout the Greater London area.

When the Tesco store was built in Finchley Mrs. Anne Davies, who is on the Executive Committee of DABB, and their representative on the council's Social Services Committee, was asked to help in the layout of the store so that it could be used by disabled people.

As a result there is easy access for wheelchairs and a special wide check-out. The management co-operated, and in consequence at least one sheltered housing association runs a regular weekly shopping bus to the store.

Much of the success of DABB can be attributed to the enthusiasm and hard work of the organiser, Mrs. Stella Morgan, and her deputy, Mr. Dick Levy, with their team of volunteers.

When Stella came to the office three years ago she thought it was going to be 'A nice little time-filler for retirement'. It has turned out a demanding, challenging job. But Stella is used to challenge. She qualified as a nurse and went back to nursing when her children were growing up during the war. She

then went to Liverpool University as a mature student. She has worked with delinquent girls and refugees and held a job in New York in conjunction with the New York State Department of Social Service.

Dick Levy was a businessman who, like Stella, wanted an interest in retirement. He brings all his knowledge of running a business and accounts to the office's affairs and takes on the organisation of such projects as Give a Lift—volunteer drivers for the disabled.

They have strong support. Their chairman is Lady Marre, who is chairman of the London Council of Social Service, a member of the Lord Chancellor's Advisory Committee on Legal Aid, and of the Milk Marketing Board. She is also a member of a group appointed to make recommendations on a projected children's unit at Christie (Cancer) Hospital, Manchester, as well as a Trustee of the City Parochial Foundation.

Newsletter

DABB's quarterly newsletter is an informative magazine carrying local news and national reports of interest to the disabled whether they are blind, deaf, or physically or mentally handicapped. Over 700 copies are distributed throughout the Borough. The editor is Miss Katharine Buchanan.

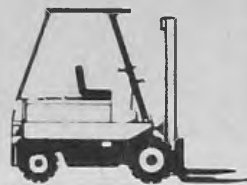
