## A MAYORAL GREETING

The new Mayor of Barnet, Councillor Victor Usher, who was re-elected to Council for Totteridge Ward, greets his Deputy Mayor, Councillor Stan Sorrell, at the Mayor Making Ceremony in Hendon Town Hall at the Annual Meeting of Barnet Council on Tuesday, May 18. # OUR 21st CARNIVAL

HAPPY 21st Birthday Finchley Carnival! And to make a special feature this year the free entertainment for the elderly and disabled is being presented on both Thursday and Friday afternoons. And any elderly or handicapped resident in the borough who would like a free pass to the Carnival which will be valid for the full three days can obtain one by writing to or telephoning the addresses at the end of this article.

It will be well worth making the trip to Victoria Park, Ballards Lane, Finchley for all three days of the Carnival — Thursday, Friday and Saturday, July 8, 9 and 10. There's non-stop entertainment from afternoon to early evening and through to 10 pm.

Thursday opens with the special entertainment and there's country dancing, a display by the Winchester Twirlettes and an exotic display of Caribbean dances and songs.

All afternoon in the Theatre Marquee the cat show is taking place. This year there are more classes than ever and there are still special awards for rescued cats. In the evening we are back in the swing with more music and song from the Afro Caribbean Festival arranged by Barnet Community Relations Council.

On Friday there's a second special event for the elderly and disabled. Barnet Schools String Orchestra will stage a mini-concert, there's Western riding and a Young Superstars competition which will test the strength and perseverance of the teams and thrill the spectators.

In the Theatre Marquee its Baby Show time sponsored by Finchley Press and Goya. There are classes for all babies from three months to 48 months.

In the evening three Folk Clubs have combined for a Folk Concert.

On Saturday the Carnival takes to the streets with the full carnival parade from Church End to Tally Ho! Corner. There's still time to enter, and the Shows Organiser is very keen to have entries from local businesses and clubs. You don't have to hire a lorry. There are prizes for walking groups.

During the afternoon at Victoria Park there will be a display by the band of the Parachute Regiment and the Glentrew Pipe Band.

# MEET OUR NEW MAYOR

BARNET'S new Mayor and Mayoress, Councillor Victor Usher and his wife, Mima, are making history. It is the first time that a Mayor of the Borough has held the office twice. For they were Mayor and Mayoress of Barnet in 1969/70.

He took up office on May 18 in one of those very British ceremonies which combine laughter and dignity.

Councillor David Burton reminded Barnet Council that 18 months ago Victor Usher had been seriously ill — so ill that it might have been the end of his public service career.

## Qualities

'But he used those qualities which we know in him so well — determination, resilience and a fighting spirit and with the support of his wife, Mima, he regained his health', Councillor Burton said.

He recalled that during his first term of office Vic Usher had been dubbed 'Barnet's kissing Mayor' because he always greeted lady Members, wives of Members and officers, and guests in this way.

On a more serious note, he listed Councillor Usher's contribution to education in the borough, particularly his work as Chairman of the Governors of Woodhouse Sixth Form College — where he had been a pupil.

Councillor Leslie Sussman also recalled aspects of the new Mayor's career: His joining the family timber and racecourse construction business in a responsible role at the age of 18;

his war service with the RAF as a navigator; his receiving the Air Efficiency Award, and the fact that he was chosen to represent the RAFVR at The Queen's coronation.

In 1973 he had taken on the chairmanship of the Friends of Chaville at a time when links between the two towns were on the verge of fading out. His enthusiastic leadership had revived the link and today there was a lively exchange between the people of Chaville and Barnet. Indeed Chaville had recognised the contribution made by Vicor Usher by naming him an Honorary Citizen of their town.

## Honoured

His work for the Order of St. John had gained him the high award of Knight Grand Cross.

'When he first stood for Council Vic Usher said that he wanted his children to live in a world free from intolerance and he has worked to make that desire a reality', Councillor Sussman said. 'His interests in local matters encompass the whole community.'

Accepting office Councillor Usher said he hoped that during the coming year all Members of the Council would work together in close harmony to serve the burgesses of Barnet. 'There will be times when we have differences of opinion but I hope you will all look on me as a grandfather figure and talk through any problems that arise.'

## Tribute

The new Mayor then paid a tribute to the retiring Mayor, Mrs. Rosa Freedman, 'You have been a shining example to all of us', he said.

He presented her with a badge of office as an ex-Mayor of Barnet and with an inscribed vellum recording the Council's appreciation of her service.

He also presented a gift from the Council to the Mayor's Escort, Mr. Joe Freedman, who accepted his Escort's badge while wearing the badge of former Mayor of Barnet — an office he held in 1972-3.

The Mayor's Chaplain will be Father Desmond Sheenan of St. Mary Magdalen Church, Whetstone.



The new Deputy Mayor is Councillor Stan Sorrell, who became a national figure when he stood as Conservative candidate for Wakefield, the by-election contested by Roy Jenkins at the birth of the SDP/Liberal Alliance. He has been a Councillor since 1978 and his particular interests have been housing and public works where his experience in London Transport has been most valuable. His wife, Mary, the Deputy Mayoress, is active in many local charities.

'The Treasure Chest will be for all the organisations who want to take part and work together and I hope we shall develop a real community spirit in this way', he told Civic News.

The Chairman of the Appeal Committee will be Mr Maurice Abbey of 6 Totnes Walk, Finchley, N2. Over the next few months Civic News will report how the people of Barnet can help the new appeal.

# Clean sweep plans for Barnet

BARNET COUNCIL is to introduce a new street sweeping programme which will mean residential roads being swept at least once a month and busy shopping centres cleaned on a daily basis.

An incentive bonus is to be introduced so that the teams are encouraged to achieve greater productivity, and the men and women operatives will be given back-up with modern equipment.

The whole borough has been divided into 'beats', 86 in all, and the majority will be manned by Cabac teams. These are five-person gangs — Barnet has women street sweepers as well as men — who ride in a specially designed vehicle which carries all the equipment and refuse storage space they need, right down to tea-making facilities.

## Teams

The gang works as a team, manually sweeping the roads and pavements, and because they are a team the work is less lonely and more pleasant.

Currently Barnet has five Cabacs on the roads and they

have proved very successful. To implement the new scheme a further three have already been purchased and four more will be bought in the current financial year.

## Recruiting

In recent years it has been increasingly difficult to recruit road sweepers. The present system under which many of the borough's roads are not able to be covered at all, requires a manpower of 121 and there are only 97 employees in the service.

To produce a new scheme which would give Barnet a better service but at no higher cost, the Public Works Committee, who are responsible for street cleansing, called in consultants Campion Willcocks & Associates.

It is their plan which Barnet hope to introduce in the near future. Talks have been held with the Trade Union representatives and in general the scheme has met with their support. A further meeting to finalise the scheme, was held with Union representatives on May 6, and then the whole plan was

put to the workforce.

Under the new proposals the full workforce will be 103 — 18 fewer than the old system. It will cost £1,100,000 a year to run — slightly less than the old scheme which has a current financial budget of £1,130,000.

Of the 103 operatives, 66 will be employed on Cabac crews, 20 will still operate one-man or one-woman beats, probably in the busy shopping areas, and 17 will man mechanical street cleaning vehicles which will be used on main thoroughfares where there are few parked cars.

The bonus scheme should increase the operative's wages by between a quarter and a third. Average earnings at present are £78 a week.

## Productivity

Special thought is being given to the 20 employees who have a disability and may not be able to sustain productivity at the level of an incentive bonus scheme. But they will not lose their jobs and they will find the overall system allows them to improve on their earnings.

It may be necessary to ba-

lance their rate of productivity with a small additional force.

## Flying Squads

Councillor Bill Hart, Chairman of the Public Works Committee, said: 'I think we must look on this as an interim scheme. There are many residential roads which I would like to see swept more than once a month.

'And I want to see a flying squad brought in who will deal with those unsightly rubbish dumps which appear out of nowhere on street verges and corners of parks and to clean off the graffiti from streets and buildings.

'I hope that if we as a Council can improve the service we shall get the backing of local residents who will help us to keep Barnet clean.'

The Borough Engineer and Surveyor, Mr. Alan Stringer, said: 'I have been concerned that Barnet is getting into a very dirty state and I believe this scheme will help us to get back to a much higher standard.'

He will be reporting back to the Committee when the scheme is implemented.
