The County Series Maps represent a district at 1:2500 or 25 inches to the mile, or 40cm to the Kilometre. If you were in a balloon it would be like being 800 metres (half a mile), above ground. Each sheet shows an area 1.5 miles west to east and 1-mile north to south. 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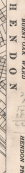

Every parcel is numbered that its area is given underneath in Acres, then braces indicating that the space is connected are included in the same reference number and area.	27 4-170 27
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The Attributes of Beach Marks and surface heights are given in Feet above the mean level of the sea at NEWLYN, and are based on the mean primary levelling of 1912-23. To refer also to the oblique longitudinal distance, and to the figures shown—L.A., L.F. etc. Note that the figure applied to the plan only and is only approximate to 4.1 ft. Further information on application.

Attribute INDIKATI also (IR. 4.2.12) refer to beach marks on buildings, walls, etc. These marked 1, preceded or followed by the height refer to surface levels.

Note: To convert Decimal parts of an Acre into Fodds and Perches, multiply by 4, this will give Fodds and Decimals of a Rod, multiply this Decimals by 40 to obtain Perches and Decimals of a Perch.
