How would you manage if you were the only one of a group of English people on holiday on the Continent who had some idea of the language?

This summer, more than 2,400 Barnet secondary school children showed that they would be able to cope in such a situation, and now have a Barnet Education Committee-sponsored Modern Language Achievement Certificate in French or German to prove it.

The certificates are intended to recognise competence in the early stages of modern language learning, rather like the grade certificates awarded to those learning to play a musical instrument, and like them, they are independent of the age of the learner.

For the average child, a Level 1 Certificate represents two years' study of the language, while a Level 2 Certificate is intended to recognise competence after three years, the point at which some children decide to take their study of a foreign language no further.

At the first level, the learner is assumed to be on a family holiday in the foreign country, and to be the only person with any knowledge of its language. The pupils have to prove their ability to find their way about, shop for necessities, organise accommodation for

the family, order appropriately in a cafe or restaurant, and talk in simple and general terms with a native speaker.

At the second level, the learners are assumed to be on a visit to a French or German family, and have to cope with the more extensive language demands which that situation creates. They must also prove their ability to find their way about alone, using public transport, talk about themselves and their way of life, and read simply-written stories and letters in the foreign language.

The tests have been devised to be as practical as possible. The students are put into a role-playing situation where the teacher takes the part of the people they would be likely to meet, such as a shop-keeper, a garage man or a receptionist.

They also have to recognise the correct response to what they are likely to hear in the foreign country, and show that they can correctly interpret road signs, public notices and other written material that they are likely to meet.

Next year, it is hoped to introduce a similar scheme for children learning Spanish, which will be of obvious benefit for those intending to holiday in a very popular part of the world!

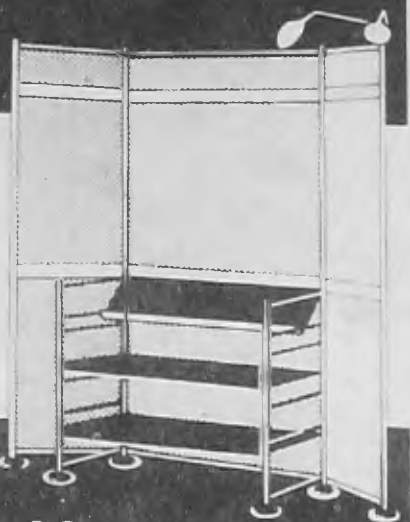

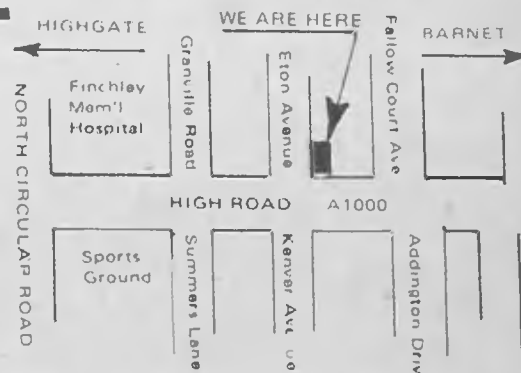

Our Lottery helps to get the disabled out and about in two new minibuses ambulances



The Mayor, Councillor Mrs. Edna James, hands over the keys to Mr. Arthur Westbury who will be in charge of bookings for the ambulance which will serve Barnet Westbury's residential homes and day centres. Between them is Mrs Mary Zelinger of Mobile '75 Leisure Coaches, which will be running the other ambulance for clubs and groups through the Volunteer Drivers' teams.

TWO BRIGHT YELLOW ambulance minibuses are at work in the borough taking the elderly and disabled to meetings, on outings, and even on shopping trips — thanks to the Barnet Borough Lottery.

On Thursday, October 16, the Mayor of Barnet, Councillor Mrs. Edna James, handed over the keys of the two ambulances at an informal ceremony at Avenue House, Finchley. At the same time she presented a cheque for £1,000 to the October winner of the top prize in the lottery.

One ambulance will be used by the borough's residential homes and day centres to take members out and about. It is being kept at Abbots Lodge Residential Home in Brunswick Park, and so, at the ceremony, the keys were received by Mr. Arthur Westbury, superintendent at the home. It will also be available to all the homes and day centres in the borough.

Volunteer drivers

The second ambulance is being used by Mobile '75 Leisure Coaches, a service formed by volunteer drivers who take elderly and disabled people to their clubs and on outings. This is run by a joint sub-committee of Barnet Volunteer Bureau and DABB, the Disablement Association of the Borough of Barnet, so the keys of this ambulance were handed to Mrs. Mary Zelinger, chairman of the sub-committee, and Mrs. Mary Young, transport officer who organises the

drivers, presented the Mayor with a posy of flowers.

Mobile '75 was set up through the Mayor's Appeal Fund in 1975/6 when Councillor Norman Hirshfield was in office. Their ambulance coaches are now feeling the effects of age and funds from the lottery are being used to provide replacement coaches.

The Mayor was welcomed by Mr. Alan Gorst, Director of Social Services, and thanked by Councillor Frank Gibson, the chairman of the Council's General Purposes Committee, which is responsible for the allocation of lottery funds, and by Councillor David Dell, chairman of Social Services, one of the major beneficiary committees.

Helps the borough

Having inspected the ambulances the Mayor said that they would soon be running round the borough carrying the message that they had been bought by funds from the lottery. 'We want everyone to see how we are spending the lottery money so that they can see how the lottery helps the borough,' she said.

She also stressed how important it was for the elderly and disabled to have mobility and to get away from the four walls of their homes which could otherwise become almost a prison.

Accepting the keys, Mrs. Mary Zelinger spoke of the work being undertaken by the volunteer drivers and escorts, and she appealed for more volunteers. Now that they had a new ambulance they would be able to meet

the needs of even more organisations — if only they could find the drivers. 'We only need an hour or two of your time, once a week, once a fortnight or even once a month,' she said. 'The ambulances are easy to drive, you don't need a special licence, and we can organise a practice session. We particularly need day-time drivers, housewives or younger retired people who may have an hour or two to spare in a morning or afternoon to take groups to their clubs and lunch centres.'

The Mobile '75 Leisure Coaches are used regularly by more than 30 local organisations such as clubs for the blind, for the young physically handicapped, for the Red Cross and for the elderly. In addition 25 organisations use the minibuses for special outings.

They are on the roads seven days a week, morning, afternoon and evening, and the drivers are volunteers recruited by the user organisation or by Barnet Volunteer Bureau.

money has gone to support the new Battle of Britain museum at RAF Station; television sets have been bought for homes for the elderly and day nurseries. New seating and a better public address system has been installed at Cophall Stadium; the ambulances are

servicing the handicapped and elderly; and we are now building five gardens for the blind in local parks.

Tickets for the lottery are sold from more than 70 outlets in the borough and are 25p each.

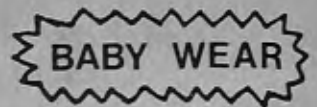

BE SEEN AND BE SAFE

BARNET ROAD SAFETY SECTION have launched a borough-wide campaign this term to encourage parents to buy fluorescent armbands for their children to wear so that they 'can be seen and be safer' when travelling to and from school in the dark winter months.

Far too many children die or are injured on our roads because drivers do not see them soon enough. Most accidents occur during the winter in poor weather conditions.

In 1978 — the latest official figures — 463 child pedestrians died on our roads in Great Britain. It is difficult to imagine a group of 463 children but if we think of all the children from one of our larger primary schools — for example Cromer Road, New Barnet — being killed in one year, then that is the national problem.

In 1979, 150 Barnet children under 16 years old, who were pedestrians, were involved in accidents — 37 being seriously injured. In addition, 58 child cyclists were injured in the borough last year.

When children wear armbands they can be seen more clearly by drivers at a greater distance. The orange fluorescent material makes them conspicuous during the day and at night the grey material shines brightly and reflects the light. It is advisable to renew armbands each year.

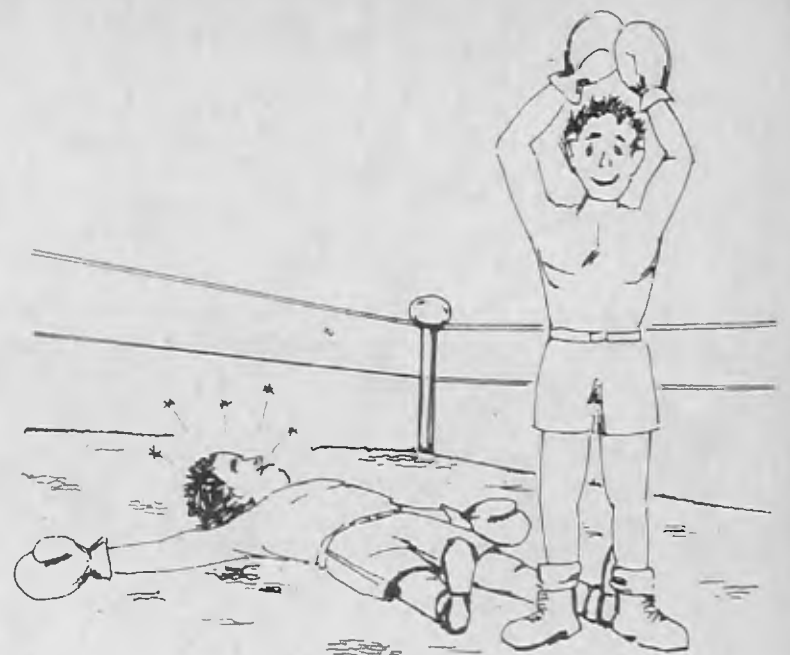



Teachers teach-in

The teaching staff from Ravenscroft School attended their second in-service training weekend at the Swaylands Study Centre, Penshurst, Kent, over a weekend in October.

During the course working groups considered school teaching practice and organisation in relation to the aesthetic, emotional and intellectual development of pupils. Particular consideration was given to the use of different types of written work and classroom experience in gaining pupil response.

to the social, political and economic change in recent years. She highlighted the trend towards change in schools being returned to the hands of teachers despite political pressures to the contrary.

Mr. S. E. Hutchinson, Headmaster of Ravenscroft affirmed his belief in the value of such in-service training weekends for teachers. 'Not only do they provide an opportunity for colleagues to get to know one another and understand different approaches better', he said, 'but they also offer great possibilities for critical analysis of a school's response to change and development'.

Taking a wheelchair test run

'EVERYTHING I asked for — and a bit more,' said Mrs. Anne Davies after her wheelchair tour of Sainsbury's new supermarket in New Barnet.

Mrs. Davies, a co-opted member of Barnet's Social Services Committee and a committee member of DABB, visited the store during the week prior to its opening with a discerning eye as to its use by other disabled shoppers.

Since 1979 when the plans for the new store were discussed, there has been close co-operation between Sainsbury's, Barnet's Planning Department and Mrs. Davies. Impressed by the layout of the supermarket, Mrs. Davies noted a number of particular aspects of assistance to the disabled and/or wheelchair customers.

- The provision of hand baskets as well as trolleys.

- Two seats at the rear of the store for the convenience of customers.

- Clear hanging signs indicating the products to be found in each aisle — easily visible from both back and front of the store.

- Wide aisles throughout.

- The accessibility of the freezer cabinets which are open top and not lidded.

- Automatic exit doors.

Mrs. Davies' wheelchair passed easily through all 21 checkout aisles but No. 1 checkout is extra wide and designed to accommodate wheelchairs. It is clearly marked with the international wheelchair symbol.

The turnstiles at the front of the store are movable for wheelchair access. Mr. Stephen Woodrow, the manager, confirmed that staff members will be available near the entrance during trading hours to open them for wheelchair customers. He and his staff are always pleased to assist disabled shoppers and if there are any difficulties he will be glad to hear directly.

At the end of her visit Mrs. Davies found the lift at ground floor level adjacent to the main entrance and exit doors to take her up to the car park where four spaces are marked out and signposted for disabled drivers' vehicles.

All the features of the new supermarket commended by Mrs. Davies reflect the long standing concern of Sainsbury's to provide a comfortable environment for all their shoppers.

Tinnitus sufferers need help

About one person in ten of the population is estimated to be afflicted by Tinnitus, a condition that mainly concerns noises in the head or ears. It is not solely the deaf or hard of hearing who suffer. Many more people with normal hearing are afflicted, young and old alike.

In its mildest form it can be a gentle susurrant of sound in the head or ears. At its worst it is a constant thunderous roar without let up by day or night. In its worst forms it can make the sufferer feel quite wretched.

Research is being done, mainly in the USA and the UK, to discover the reasons for the condition and to seek alleviation or perhaps a cure. The trouble is that so little is known about the condition and how it commences that even doctors have been known to ignore it or use the well known nostrum 'you have to learn to live with it'.

The fact that the condition does not kill, just drives some people with it to feel suicidal, is one of the reasons why it tends to be pushed aside without priority. For the sufferer, sadly, there is only one priority, the noise itself, for it is ever present in a most persistent way. The researchers and doctors are now becoming aware of the need to give some help but most important of all is that sufferers have now com-

menced to try to help themselves.

In July, 1979, after a series of television and radio programmes, Jack Ashley MP, under the umbrella of the Royal National Institute for the Deaf, called a meeting at the House of Commons and with an attendance of over 200 people from all over the UK, the British Tinnitus Association was formed.

Groups and Branches have sprung up all over the country and in North West London a branch was formed on March 15. This branch now has 40 members and many more are joining.

The monthly meetings have proved to sufferers they are not alone; their condition is not a figment of their own imagination. They can see others who have this affliction. We exchange information on the onset and severity of the noises, and regimens of health or diet that will help. We seek out sympathetic doctors and try to inform those who have either not heard of the condition or do not know what research and alleviation is available.

We have enlisted the help of the local press and had a moving and very excellent response. We have had a doctor, who himself has the condition, come to our meeting and participate in a

discussion on the medical aspects of this condition.

We correspond with other groups and branches in the country and exchange information. We subscribe to the journal 'Hearing' which has an insert Newsletter for the British Tinnitus Association. This gives details of the latest research and also the various drugs tested to alleviate the suffering from noise or allow a good night's sleep.

Research has shown that 'maskers' and low volume hearing aids, both available on the National Health, can be of use to some small number of sufferers.

Our groups must grow and spread, primarily so that sufferers are not cut off and lonely, and thereby aggravate their suffering. Also so that they may learn what can be done to help them. Most of all people should band together to secure more professional treatment of their ailment and encourage research and investigation into the condition.

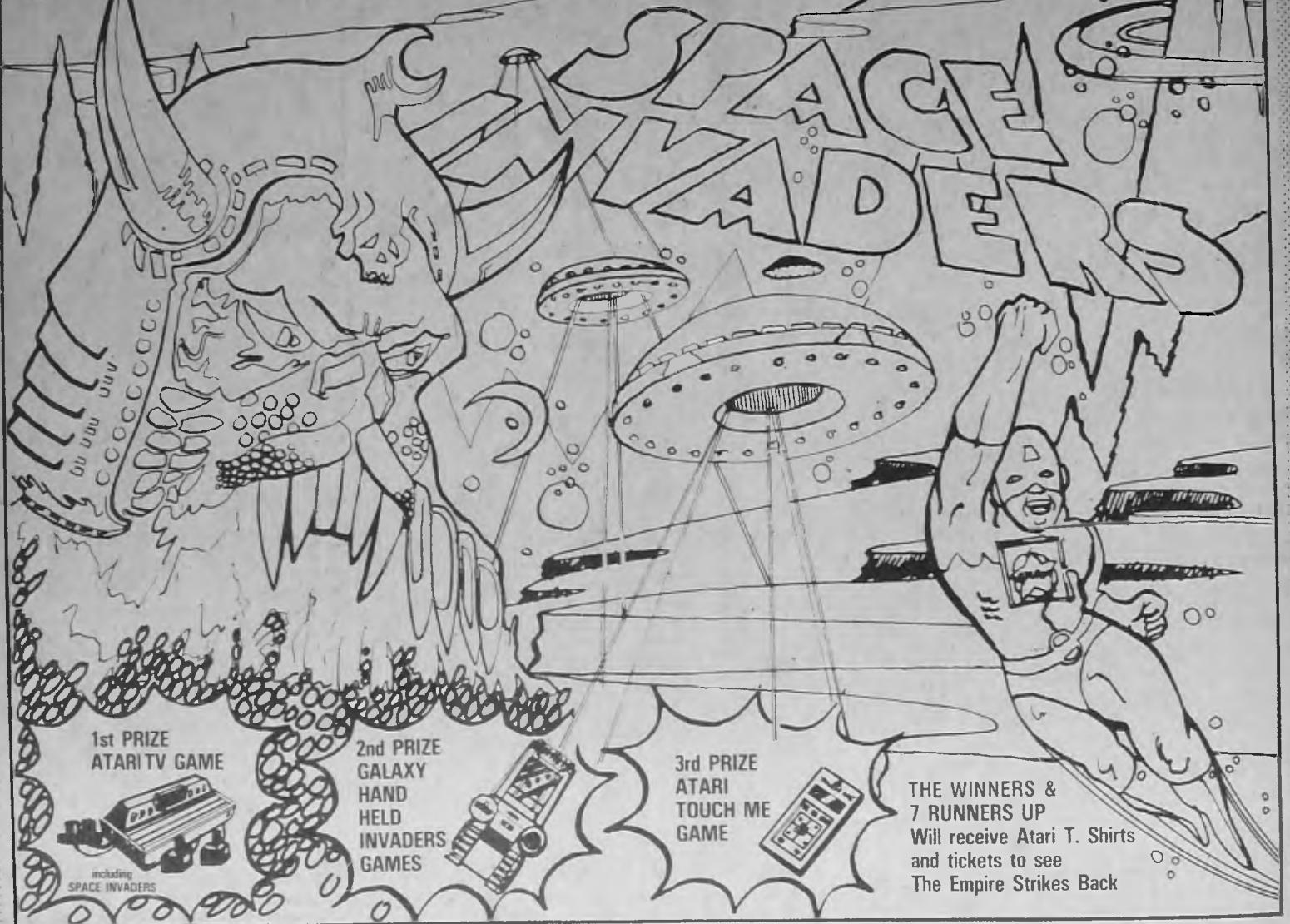
Crisis fund

THIS IS THE STORY of a remarkable young man: his determination, courage, ingenuity and self-discipline.

Douglas Fitch, who is nearly 18, lives in Martins Walk, Muswell Hill, just inside the Barnet boundary. He finds speech difficult, cannot control his arm movements and even walking is a problem.

He 'talks' to those who cannot understand him by tapping out words with his nose on a small machine called a communicator which prints out his sentences. He does his study notes and examination work in a similar manner — by typing with his nose on an electric typewriter reaching speeds of 35 words a minute.

His own fighting qualities combine with a sunny disposition and strong parental support, have enabled him to acquire the following examination results over a two-year period: 'O' level mathematics; English; history; and commerce; CSE 1 in art and design; and CSE 3 in social studies.

In history, he had no formal tuition whatsoever. He drew up his own plan of study and bought his own textbooks or borrowed them from the library.

He sat his examinations, some at school and some at home, with a

invigilator present on every occasion. His only concession was a 20-minute rest period every hour, giving him four hours to complete a three-hour paper. But Douglas, with the encouragement of his parents, Leslie and Alice Fitch, wants to aim even higher.

He has now started studying for his 'A' level mathematics and economics. He is also investigating the possibility of a career in computers. To help him, Barnet Educational Department lent him a micro computer during the October half-term holiday when it was

not needed in a school.

On Wednesday, October 22, Councillor Mrs. Rosa Freedman, Chairman of the Education Committee, visited Douglas at his home. Congratulating him on his achievements she said how proud she was to be able to present him with his 'O' level and CSE certificates.

She was able to see Douglas using the micro computer which had been delivered to his home only two days before and which he was able to use after half an hour's instruction and a read of the manual.

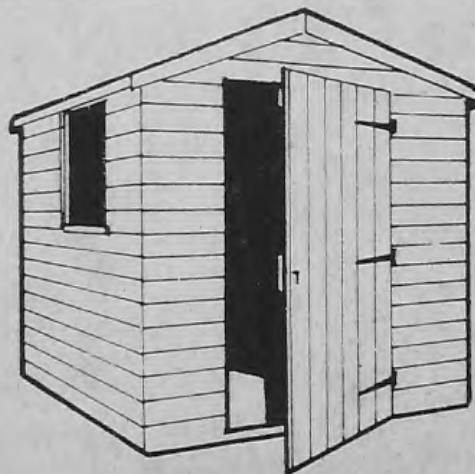

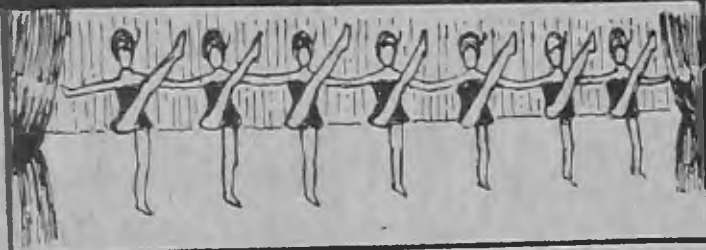
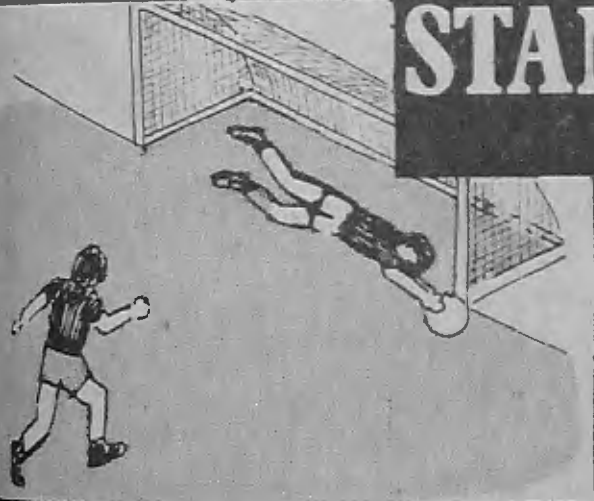

National Foster Care Week in October focused attention on this essential service. One of the highlights locally was an evening when foster parents and would-be foster parents met at Orange Hill Junior School to exchange ideas and useful hints. Guest of honour was Brian Murphy, star of George and Mildred fame, who was joined by his real wife to talk about their experience in fostering six children, all of whom still keep in contact with them.

All over London there are children who need a home, a little love, a lot of understanding and a sense of belonging. Come and meet some of them:

Gary

Gary, is 13 years old; a small pale boy looking younger than his age. He is living in a Children's Home where he is lonely and unhappy and would dearly love to live with a family where he would receive the affection and attention he craves.

As a baby Gary was neglected and virtually abandoned by his mother. He has been fostered before but things did not work out for him. However, he is very keen to try again.

With adults, David can be shy but, if he takes to you, he soon starts to chatter and play and can be very good company. He has had some difficulties with his schooling but he is coping better with some extra help.

Tony

Martin demands a lot of affection and cuddles and generally acts younger than his age. He has been treated as a baby and uses this to get his own way, sometimes at David's expense.

Martin and David wish to keep in contact with their older brother. Their parents will also probably keep in touch, but the likelihood of the children returning home is remote.

Terry

Terry is a year old and still weighs only 14lbs. Apart from brief stays in hospital he has spent his life so far in a foster home. This year has been a difficult one because Terry has been such a fragile baby to care for, but it has been a rewarding one too for his foster mother, because at last he is showing considerable progress. Terry is alert and loving, although he is functioning at the level of a six month old.

Now that Terry is stronger, we are looking for a long-term



foster home for him where he will receive regular medical checks.

It is unlikely that Terry will ever go home to his mother, but she sees him regularly and would like to continue to do so when he moves to a long-term foster home.

Peter

Peter is a good looking, blond, blue-eyed five-year-old. He is an unhappy, unsettled child who can be very difficult to cope with at times. Peter can be fiercely independent and will stand up for his rights against adults or other children even if he knows he will come off worst. He thrives on adult attention, however, particularly liking men, and loves the fuss that can be made over him when getting dressed or having a bedtime story.

Peter can be very rewarding to those caring for him but at other times can be frustrating and difficult. He is a confused, angry little boy who desperately needs the security of a foster home where his behaviour can be tolerated and understood.

James

James is an attractive seven-month-old baby. He has a West Indian mother and is unlikely to ever go home to her. At present he is with a short-term foster mother and we are looking for a long-term family for him as soon as possible.

James is physically very well though it seems that he is not as alert and developing as rapidly as he might be. He also has an especially piercing scream!

GARDEN SUBURB

Hampstead Garden Suburb was created in the first quarter of this century by a group of architectural and environmental pioneers led by Dame Henrietta Barnett. Today its special character is protected by a conservation area and its residents, through local societies and the Hampstead Garden Suburb Institute, form a strong, village-style community contributing to the cultural life of the whole borough.



COUNCILLOR RICHARD BLAUTEN was first elected to represent the Garden Suburb Ward in 1974. He has been a strong campaigner against the heavy lorries which threaten the environment of local residents and a firm supporter of open planning committee meetings.

He was educated at Clifton College, Bristol, and, before going to Sheffield University — where he obtained a law degree — worked as a volunteer teacher and housemaster in Malawi, Central Africa. He has since kept up his interest in Africa, joining the Royal African Society and writing newspaper and magazine articles, and a number of pamphlets on the subject.

He currently serves on the Education, Social Services and Libraries and Arts Committees. He is a former member of the Public Works Committee and a former vice-chairman of the Education Committee and chairman of the Schools and Special Services Sub-committee.

Chairman of the governing bodies of Ravenscroft School and Orange Hill School, he is also a member of the governing body of a group of primary schools: Brooklands, Garden Suburb, Chalgrove and Bell Lane.

He has served for a number of years on the Barnet Community Relations Council. Chairman of the all-party pro-EEC effort in Barnet during the Common Market Referendum campaign, he is currently a member of the National Council of the European Movement and its Speakers Panel.

He is chairman of the English-speaking Union Debating Society and chairman of the Association of Young Conservative Councillors. He is also a member of the Foreign Affairs Standing Committee of the Bow Group.

He is married and has a young daughter. A Freeman of the City of London, he works as editor of an international advertising and marketing magazine.



COUNCILLOR MICHAEL MAX has lived in the Borough most of his life and was educated at the Garden Suburb School, Haberdashers' Aske's and University College, London, where he gained his degree as a bachelor of Law. He is a solicitor in a city practice.

He was elected to the Council for the Garden Suburb Ward in 1978. Since then he has served on the Town Planning and Research, Public Works and Community Land committees. He is now vice-chairman of the Town Planning and Research Committee and also serves on the Central Area Road Safety Committee.

'While Councillors must always take a particular interest in the affairs of their own ward, they must try to make decisions on the basis of what will best benefit the borough. We must not be too parochial,' he told Civic News.

He is a governor of a group of primary schools — Bell Lane, Brooklands, Chalgrove and Garden Suburb and also of Henrietta Barnett School.

In May of this year he was elected chairman of the Hampstead Garden Suburb Institute and at present is heavily involved in two major problems — the defective north wing and the proposals for a new art wing for the Institute and a laboratory wing for Henrietta Barnett School.

A former show secretary of the Hampstead Garden Suburb Horticultural Society, he is keenly interested in gardening and still exhibits in the society's shows. His other interests include model railways, books and listening to music.

He was commissioned in the Royal Artillery during his National Service between 1955 and 1957.

His wife, Wendy, whom he married in 1962, has lived in the Suburb most of her life. She teaches the cello in ILEA primary schools.

They have four sons — Richard, Edward, Robert and James — all at school.



COUNCILLOR MRS PHYLLIS NEVARD has lived in Hampstead Garden Suburb for nearly 30 years, serving as an elected representative for the ward since 1971. Her interest in politics is of long-standing and before her election she contested seats on two occasions. She has also served as chairman, vice-chairman and secretary of her ward Conservative Association.

A member of the Church of England, she was educated at the Convent of Notre Dame de Sion in London and retains an active interest in schools and young people. She is a member of the Education Committee and on both the Further Education and Youth and Community Services Sub-committees. In addition she is a governor of Bell Lane, Brooklands, Chalgrove and Garden Suburb Primary Schools and of Whitefield Secondary School, and a manager of St. Mary's C. of E. Junior School in Finchley.

She also serves on the Allotments Committee, reflecting her interest in gardening. And she is a member of the Housing Committee, taking a particular interest in housing for the elderly.

A working director in her husband's office equipment and stationery business, she still finds time to take an active interest in community life. She is a member of the New Hampstead Garden Suburb Trust and the Institute, and she maintains a vigilant guard on matters of conservation, supporting any move to enhance the quality of life in the area.

One issue on which she is very involved at present is to ban heavy lorries from Falloeden Way. She is also a committee member of Abbeyfield Housing Society, which has purchased Erskine Hall to provide sheltered housing for the elderly.

Pavement parkers pay £60

EARLIER THIS YEAR Barnet Council decided to take action against drivers who parked their vehicles on the pavements, causing obstruction and even danger to pedestrians.

The first step was to put up notices in certain roads where such parking was particularly blatant. Drivers were warned in Civic News and the local Press that if they persisted in ignoring the notices then prosecutions would follow.

The action was the result of a decision by the Council's Public Works Committee to make an effort to

end pavement parking in areas where it is a real problem.

The first two such cases were heard by Highgate magistrates on Wednesday October 15. Two drivers, both from Hendon Lane, Church End, Finchley, were accused of driving on the footway and with obstructing the highway in Nether Street, Church End, Finchley.

In each case the defendants were fined £10 for the first offence, £30 for the second and ordered to pay £20 costs — a total of £60 each.

More such cases are to follow. You have been warned.

Voyage of discovery

A VOYAGE OF DISCOVERY around our own borough can be taken within the precincts of Church Farm House Museum, Hendon. The tour operators are 20 member societies and groups of Barnet Borough Arts Council who have brought together an exhibition of The Things that go on in Barnet Borough. This melds the past and the present of our town and is enlivened by talks, music, country dancing and poetry readings.

You can delve into Barnet's past history or help protect the fine buildings and landscapes of the borough through such organisations as the Finchley Society; Mill Hill and Hendon Historical Society; Mill Hill Preservation Society; Barnet and District Local History Society; Hendon and District Archaeological Society, and the local branch of the National Trust.

You can enjoy the arts through All Saints Arts Centre which offers music, dance and drama; the Barnet Centre Association with its programmes of folk

music, international folk dancing, crafts and arts exhibitions, its studio theatre and music classes; or through Hampstead Garden Suburb Institute with its classes in drawing and painting, embroidery, sculpture, calligraphy and jewellery making.

Intellectual pursuits are covered by Barnet Anglo-French Club, New Barnet Literary and Debating Society and the Workers' Educational Association.

And this wide ranging exhibition also includes displays by Barnet and District Gem and Mineral Club; the Barnet Federation of Children's Books Group; Community and Recreational Arts in Barnet (CRAB); East Finchley Neighbourhood Association; the Finchley Antiques Appreciation Group and Edgware Week.

As you tour the stands you discover exponents of the gentle art of embroidery with gold thread and stump work.

Wood carving, bronze casting, fine pottery and bold earthenware are on show and many societies are displaying their new season's programmes.

A visit to this exhibition, which runs to the end of this month, could well mean a much more interesting winter ahead.

Talk about your memories

MEMORIES ARE VALUABLE. They are human experiences of history. When many of the over 70s today recall their childhood they are speaking of a world which disappeared with the end of World War I.

It is a world which, while documented in books and photographs, is enriched by human memory. The Finchley Society are hoping to capture some of these memories as seen through the eyes of elderly people who spent their childhood in this area.

Every Saturday and Sunday at 2.30 pm until the end of this month they will

be at Hendon Church Farm House Museum with a tape recorder and they would like all pensioners who have memories of the borough as it was in the first 20 years of this century — or indeed the last decade of the previous century, to come along and talk about those memories.

If you have such memories or know a senior citizen whose recollections of the early years are clear and informative, do help to get these stories recorded for posterity. Memories are often too precious to lose.

Then the Mayor presented the Gold badges to recipients of the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme. These went to four members of Christ's College Cadet Force, Robert Cinnamon of West Heath Avenue, Golders Green; Jonathan Matthews, Gresham Gardens, Golders Green; Rafic Abu-Haider, Friern Barnet Lane, Friern Barnet; Sanjay Vyas, Woodland Way, Mill Hill; and to John Lake, Talbot Avenue, East Finchley.

The Mayor told them: 'It is very pleasing, at this Council meeting, to have evidence of the qualities and sense of service of the young people of our borough.'

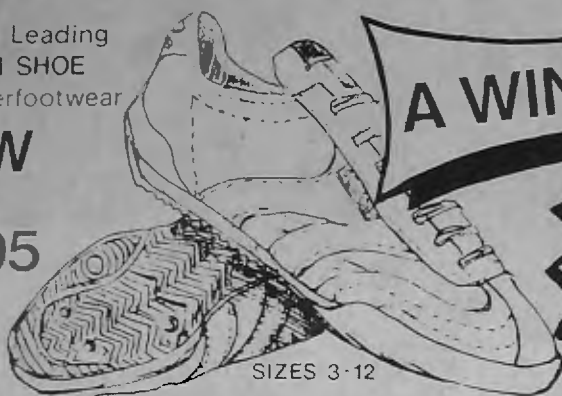

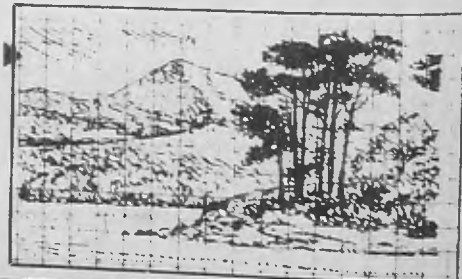
