The County Series Maps represent a district at 1:2500 or 25 inches to the mile, or 40cm to the Kilometre. If you were in a balloon it would be like being 800 metres (half a mile), above ground. Each sheet shows and area 1.5 miles west to east and 1-mile north to south.
