LA DELIVRANCE, better known as the 'Naked Lady', the statue which stands at the junction of the North Circular Road and Regents Park Road, Finchley, is probably the best known landmark in the Borough of Barnet.

The statue is in bronze and is the work of Emile Gillaume, the greatest French Sculptor of his time. It stands about 15 feet from foot to tip of sword.

It was presented to the former Finchley UDC by Viscount Rothermere and unveiled by David Lloyd George in 1927. The late Ald Alfred Pike recalled in the Finchley Society Magazine in 1972 that Lord Rothermere frequently visited his mother in Totteridge and chose the site for the statue on his route.

MAYOR'S MESSAGE

I AM DELIGHTED to welcome back into our community life Barnet Council's own magazine Barnet Borough News. It not only enables me to wish you the compliments of the coming season but also to tell you about my Appeal for the year which, as many of you know, is in aid of an Activity Centre for the disabled at John Grooms in Edgware.

The activity centre will be for the use of the residents of John Grooms and for all disabled people throughout the borough, especially the young.

The basic philosophy of John Grooms Association since its foundation in 1886 has been to help the disabled to help themselves. In 1932 John Grooms moved from the City to Edgware and the large building on three floors, still in use today, was largely for the production of hand-made flowers. In 1938 there were 200 workers, mainly the disabled with calipers and crutches — very few wheelchairs. Now there are between 65 and 70 and about half of these are in wheelchairs.

It has now been decided that the build-

ing should be redesigned to become an activity centre for sports, crafts and social events. I believe it will fill a real need in our community and I appeal to everyone for their support for such a worthwhile venture.

I am delighted to tell you that in the first half of my year in office, due to the hard work of my Appeal Committee and to people, clubs and organisations who have held money-raising events, the fund is already well past the five figure mark with donations coming in all the time and many of the larger events still to come.

If you can help, either individually or as a group, to raise funds for my appeal I will be most grateful. All donations, large or small, should be made out to the Mayor's Appeal Fund and sent to the Mayor's Parlour, Town Hall, The Burroughs, Hendon, NW4 4BG.

I hope, that with your help, sufficient money will be raised during the year to make this exciting vision a reality.

Holiday closing dates

BARNET COUNCIL'S main Town Halls and offices will be closed over the Christmas and New Year holidays from Christmas Day, December 25 to January 2 inclusive.

However, throughout the holidays there will be standby teams from housing, social services and the Borough Engineer's Department, to look after emergency situations on a 24-hour basis.

The emergency number is 202 8282 which operates at all times when the main Town Halls are closed.

Housing depots will be closed on the same days as council offices except for Woodhouse Road Depot, North Finchley, which will be manned by a skeleton staff on Friday, December 28 and Monday, December 31 to deal with urgent repairs only.

LIBRARIES

The public libraries and museums will be closed from Christmas Eve, December 24, to Thursday, December 27 inclusive, opening again for the Friday and Saturday of Christmas

week. The only exception is the travelling library service which will operate until 4 pm on Christmas Eve and then close until Wednesday January 2 when it will be on the road again.

For New Year's week the libraries will be closed on Monday, December 31 and New Year's Day. The four main libraries, Hendon, Edgware, Church End Finchley and Chipping Barnet, will open on Wednesday, January 2 and all the other libraries will be open as normal from Thursday, January 3.

COPTHALL POOLS

Copthall Swimming Pool will close for three days over the Christmas holiday, from Christmas Eve to Boxing Day inclusive, open on Thursday, December 27 to December 31 from 9 am to 5 pm and close for New Year's Day. The pools will resume normal opening hours from January 2.

The public are asked to co-operate with the Council and to use the emergency number only in cases of real necessity.

Montclair USA
— here we come

SIXTH-FORMERS from Barnet schools and colleges or who live in the borough may have a chance to visit the Borough's link town of Montclair, USA.

The Friends of Montclair are hoping to arrange an exchange visit for young people aged 16½ to 18 in early April if sufficient support can be rallied.

Montclair, New Jersey, is a residential suburban town, close to New York and also near pleasant countryside.

The visit will run for 2½ weeks when the students will stay with a family. In July a group from Montclair will visit England and stay with Barnet families. So that one of the conditions of the visit is to be prepared to host an American student in exchange. Details of costs are not yet known but the visit is expected to be about £400 to £450.

There would also be a need for teachers to organise and escort the group. The organisers' fares would be paid and they would stay with a Montclair family.

Applications from students or teachers wishing to take part should be sent to Cllr Frank Gibson, Members' Room, Town Hall, Hendon NW4 4BG.

FOR ADULTS

It is also hoped that an eight-day exchange visit for adults can be organised for May 1985 with a return visit to Barnet by Montclair residents in mid-July. The week could be extended by members making their own arrangements to stay on and visit other areas.

Again residents of Barnet interested in taking part should write to Cllr Frank Gibson.

BARNET Cophall Swimming Pools have been voted the best managed swimming complex in Greater London and the South East in the 1984 Sports Council Management Awards.

In competition with more than 120 pools in the region they showed the Sports Council judging panel how they made full use of the building, ran training programmes for all grades of swimmers, kept the pool in use, clean and attractive throughout the year and catered for about 500,000 swimmers.

Andy Sutch, head of the Sports Council's Regional Facility Team, said: 'The assessment panel considered that Cophall Pools have developed a sound management strategy and took full account of the important role played by the pool in the borough.

'Alan Hime's team have made good progress towards a pattern of full participation — involving all the various groups and individuals who might use a competition pool.

And the crowning verdict: The panel members all agreed that this was certainly a pool to which they themselves would wish to return as swimmers.

To gain the award the Cophall Team put together a report explain-

ing how they planned the pools use. The panel interviewed Councillor David Clarke, chairman of Development and Estates Committee, and Alan Stringer, Borough Engineer and Surveyor, as well as Alan Hime and his management team. Andy Clarke, deputy manager, Harry Lewis, plant engineer and Fred Westphal, assistant manager. They toured the pools complex and saw something of the training programme which begins with mothers and babies of under six

months and goes through to competitive swimming.

Alan Hime has recently been appointed manager of the England Yorkshire Bank Swimming Squad and he feels that there is international or age group potential among his own Barnet Cophall Swimming Team.

'Cophall is one of the most intensively used pools,' he said. 'Every morning you will find club swimmers training from about 5 am onwards. All day long we have

classes, schools swimming, training and recreation swimming. We are doing well with our synchronised swimming classes, and our keep fit and aerobics classes.

'In the evenings the lane swimming is still very popular and we offer free of charge unofficial training and encouragement.

'We are bursting at the seams and now that the retiling is over we are on the way to a record attendance for the coming year.'

Adelina Oprean in Concert in Barnet

One of the most exciting arts events on the Borough's 1984/85 calendar is the International Chamber Concert series organised by Barnet Libraries and Arts with sponsorship by leading local companies.

Internationally known musicians have been invited to present four concerts in the Borough.

The season opened with the Borodin Trio on Sunday November 11 at the Lynne Austin Hall, Golders Green. This concert, sponsored by the Bank Leumi UK, was a sell out and proved an evening of magnificent music.

The second concert of the series features Adelina Oprean, violinist, accompanied by Justin Oprean and will be held at St. Jude's Church, Central Square, Hampstead Garden Suburb, on Sunday, December 9 at 8 pm.

Adelina Oprean was born in Romania in 1955 and started playing the violin at the age of seven in the Music School in Sibiu. She studied at leading conservatories and at the International Menuhin Music Academy in Gstaad where her teachers included Alberto Lysy, Yehudi Menuhin and Victor Libermann.

She has won many chamber music

prizes including the Joachim Violin Competition in Austria in 1981 and the Carl Flesch International Violin Competition in London in 1982.

Her accompanist for this concert of Schubert, Beethoven, Debussy and Bartok, is Justin Oprean, considered one of the best known of the younger generation of Romanian pianists.

He studied at Bucharest Music Academy and is a lecturer at the Universities of Bonn and Cologne.

The third concert in the series will feature Yitkin Seow, pianist, in an evening of Chopin. This concert, sponsored by the Hugin Group, will be held at St. Jude's Church on Wednesday, February 6.

The final concert features the Varsovia String Quartet playing Mozart, Beethoven and Schubert and has been sponsored by STC Telecommunications. It will be held at St. Jude's on Friday, March 8.

It is the first time that Barnet has arranged a series of concerts with internationally known musicians. Booking forms are available at local libraries and telephone bookings may be made from Monday to Friday, 10.30 am to 1 pm to the Arts Officer, Barnet Libraries, Ravens-

Tickets are £4.50 and £2.50 and there are concessions for pensioners, students and the unemployed (£2.50 and £1.75). It is also possible to book for the three remaining concerts for the price of two tickets.

FIFTEEN years ago most council tenants thought the idea of buying their home went alongside dreams of winning the pools or inheriting money from a long-lost uncle in Australia.

But in 1969 Barnet Council was one of the first local authorities to introduce the sale of council houses to tenants at a generous discount.

Today almost every council tenant has a right to buy their home at discounts on market value which can be as high as 60 per cent for long-term tenants.

There is mortgage money available, help and advice is on hand, and there is even a scheme for those

who cannot afford the full mortgage.

Already 3,200 of Barnet's tenants have bought their homes. So what is it all about, this Right to Buy your Home Scheme, and how does it work?

The action centre for the borough is Stag House, Burnt Oak Broadway, where the sales team, headed by John Nice and Tim Madden, are based. There are leaflets describing the scheme and people to talk to.

Here, we can only set out some of the basic facts.

Who has the right to buy?

Answer: Most council tenants (in houses, flats and maisonettes. The main exceptions are tenants who

live in sheltered housing; in homes which have been designed or substantially adapted for disabled people; and in short lease accommodation.

What discount will you get if you buy your council home?

A: After just two years as a tenant — and not necessarily in the home you are living in now — you will receive a discount of 32 per cent on market value. This grows by one per cent for every additional year up to a maximum of 60 per cent for tenants with 30-plus years.

However, as a basic rule the Council cannot sell the house below the land and building costs.

This is a difficult area to explain briefly. It usually only applies to houses built or substantially modernised after March 1974. It means that if the market value is £30,000 and you qualify for a 60 per cent discount, you might expect to buy for £12,000. But, if the cost of the land and the cost to the council of building the dwellings adds up to more than £1,000 — let's say £15,000 — then you will have to pay that £15,000 which is known as the 'cost floor'.

Now comes the big question: **Can we afford to buy?**

Notice the word 'we'. You and adult members of your family who live in the house permanently have the right to buy jointly.

While Council mortgages are available it is often better to go to a building society and council house purchasers are helped with their

applications. The societies will usually lend 2½ times the annual income of the main earner plus one year's income of the lower earner. So a couple earning £8,000 and £7,000 could purchase jointly with a mortgage of about £27,000.

There is good news for those who want to buy but feel that at this stage they cannot afford the full mortgage payments. They have two alternatives. They can register their wish to buy with a deposit of £100 (fully returnable), and wait for two years before going ahead with the purchase. Meanwhile the price of the house will be frozen for two years from the date of the application to buy, so this is an inflation-proof deal.

Or would-be buyers, feeling they need a longer time before coping with a full mortgage, may take up the shared ownership option which allows them to buy 50 per cent of the house and rent the rest. At a later stage they can increase their share of ownership and progress to full purchase.

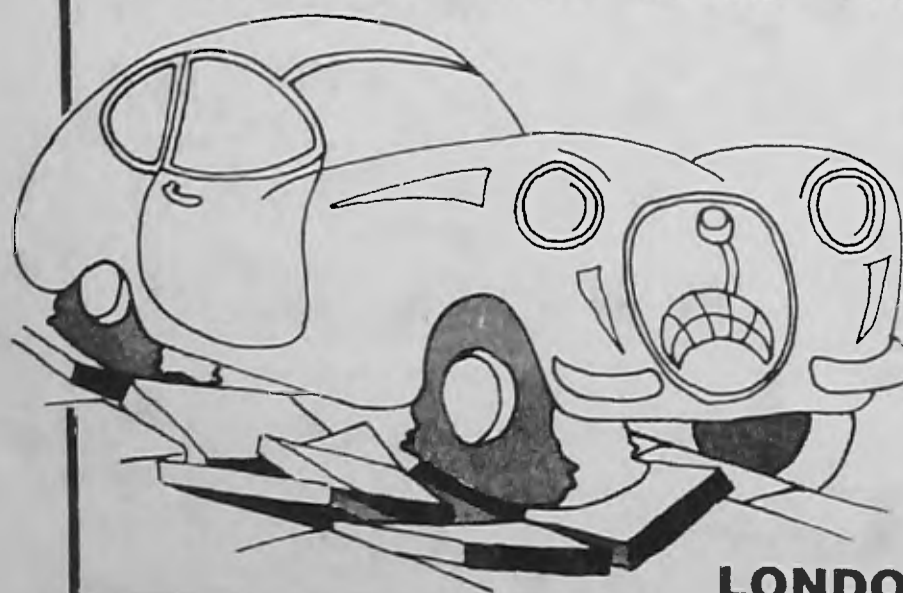

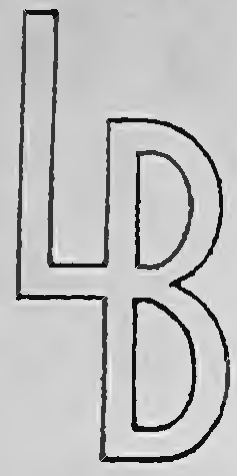

pared, cooked and distributed by the League of Jewish Women with funding from the borough.

Sadly, as more married women go out to work, there are fewer volunteers coming forward.

Can you help? The WRVS are looking for people who could spare about four hours once a week or even once a fortnight, to go out as drivers or helpers to take these meals to the housebound.

Miss Eileen Stanley knows the Barnet Meals-on-Wheels scene from both aspects. She joined Finchley Council as an administrative officer in the former public health department, came to Social Services in 1970 and from 1976 was closely involved with administration of the Meals-on-Wheels Service. On her retirement in 1982 she took on the job of Borough Organiser for the WRVS, taking over from Mrs Jill Hewett whose long association with the WRVS dates from the war.

Jill's retirement pinpoints a new problem faced by the WRVS. Headquarters of the service felt that younger members should be taking on responsible office and they sent out a directive to all organisers asking them to step down from office once they reached of 65.

This led to the retirement of some long-service members and has made the need for new volunteers even more essential. There is no ban on volunteers working over the age of 65. The ban only applies to organiser posts.

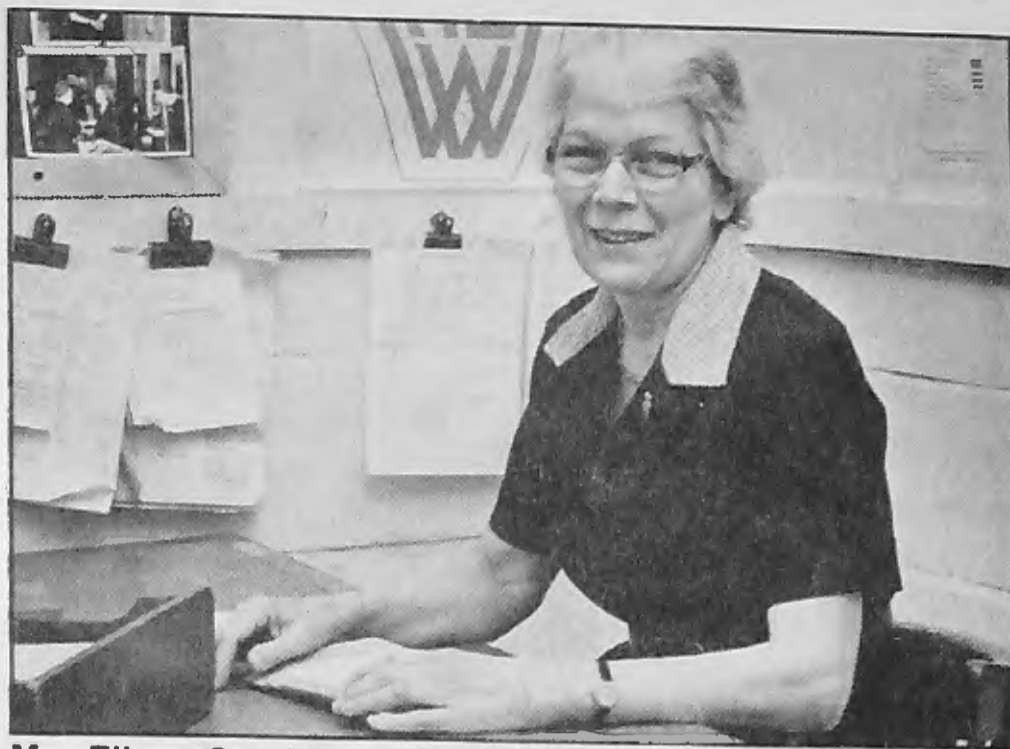
Nor is there a ban on men volunteers. The WRVS are only too pleased when men offer to help on the Meals-on-Wheels Service.

'We have 300 volunteers and would like as many again,' Eileen Stanley said. 'The teams go out in all weathers delivering 720 meals five days a week. We have to cope with emergency peaks when relatives are on holiday, and bad weather when elderly people cannot get out.'

'It takes about four hours from collecting the lunches to completing the delivery and although we love it when people can give us one day a week, we do understand how difficult that can be.'

'We also need help in the offices and those hours can be more flexible.'

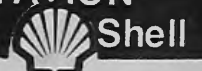

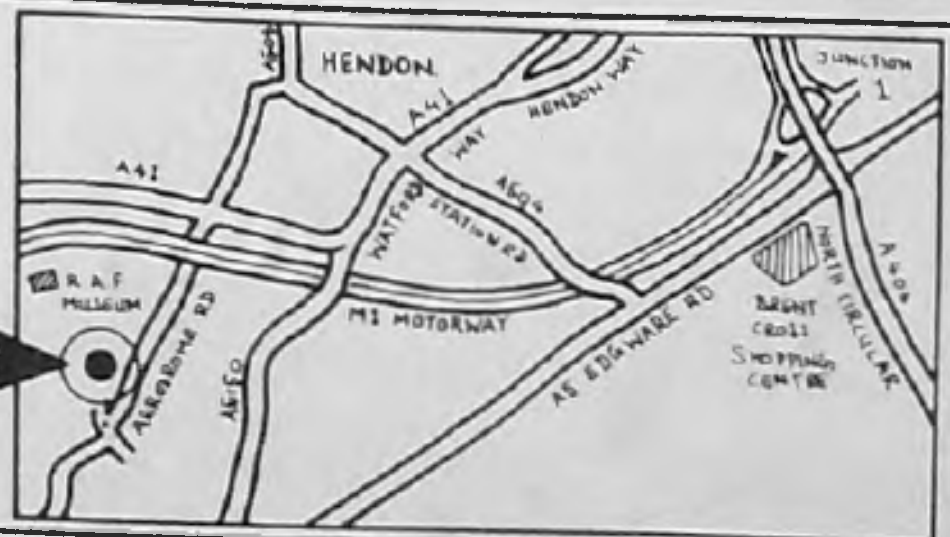

Whoops! Owners in the dog house

DOG OWNERS in Paris do it. Dog owners in New York do it. Now Barnet Council want dog owners in the borough to do it . . .

Clear up the mess after their dogs have done a 'whoopsie', that is. And they have supported a suggestion that it should be introduced legally.

The problem of the control of dogs was discussed by the Council's Development and Estates Committee.

There have been an increasing number of complaints about dogs fouling parks and children's play areas. It is argued that children run the risk of being covered in excreta when they play in Council parks and that soil is heavily contaminated with the eggs of toxocara canis, a dog parasite, which can survive for up to six years.

The committee considered a 2,003-signature petition requesting that the Council provide dog-free recreation areas.

There are a large number of dog owners in Barnet — approximately 5,900 dog licences are bought each year — and most would be likely to oppose any suggestion that dogs be banned.

A number of other London

boroughs have similar problems and have not, as yet, found proper solutions.

New law

The suggestion that a new law be made obliging dog owners to clear up any mess is being considered by the Home Office. But it is thought there would still be a problem of enforcement.

The accepted practice of most local authorities seems to be to ban dogs from playgrounds, special areas and some sports areas through by-laws.

In reply to a letter about the possibility of the Council making new by-laws banning dogs from a number of additional areas, the Home Secretary replied that the areas would require special protection and be enclosed to keep out dogs. There should also be places nearby where dogs could be freely exercised.

ARTISTS HOPE FOR GOOD TURNOUT

ARTISTS Eamonn Holliday and Dave Williams are exhibiting at Totteridge Library while working in an adjoining studio.

They are giving talks and slide shows and hope schools and clubs will visit for discussions.

It would be necessary to fence areas to enforce the by-law. Fencing is expensive. It would cost about £42,000 to fence the 35 unenclosed children's playgrounds within the borough. If it were also decided to set aside dog exercise areas, then the cost would be that much greater. And fences could ruin the character of some parks.

The committee decided to include money for some playground fencing in next year's budget. The borough engineer and surveyor will report on experimental open areas for dogs, as well as measures adopted by other authorities, and arrange for code of practice posters to be put up in parks.

Chief officers will report on a proposed code of conduct for owners, plus ways of enforcing it, and the committee agreed to ask police to continue to keep an eye on unaccompanied dogs.

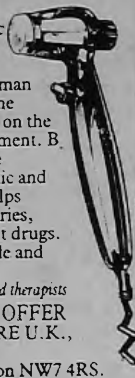

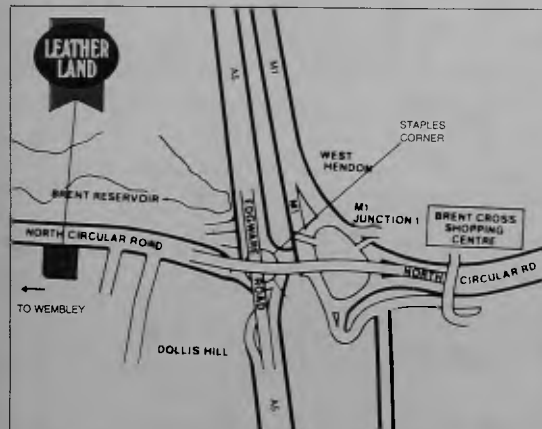

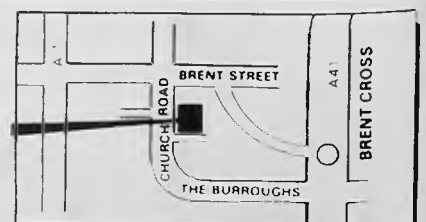
