CELEBRATING FREEDOM

With drums beating and bayonets fixed the band and troops of the Corps of Royal Engineers marched through the streets of Barnet on Saturday, July 24, to celebrate the granting of the Freedom of the Borough to the Corps in the centenary year of the Postal and Courier Depot which is based at Inglis Barracks, Mill Hill.

In the afternoon the troops marched through centre of the Borough and in the evening the beating of retreat at the Barracks marked the end of a day of pageantry and civic pride.

The Town Hall, Hendon, flower-decked and flying the flags of the Borough and the Corps of Royal Engineers, was the focal point of the morning's ceremony. The troops paraded on the car park opposite and the Mayor and Councillors walked in procession from the Town Hall to the parade ground wearing their robes of office and preceded by the mace bearers.

The Band of the Corps of Royal Engineers in their scarlet and blue uniforms played a medley of London and military music as the Mayor, accompanied by the Chief Royal Engineer, Lieut-Gen. Sir David Willison; the Postal Courier Depot Commandant, Col. Rolf James; and the Town Clerk,

Mr. Michael Bennett, inspected the troops, many of whom bore medals signifying distinguished service.

The Mayor and Councillors then returned to the Town Hall, where, on a dais in front of the building Sir David made the Freeman's declaration on behalf of the Corps of Royal Engineers and received the Scroll of Freedom.

The scroll, a hand-inscribed parchment encased in a silver casket, was the work of a retired council employee, Mr. Raymond Clarke.

The Freedom of the Borough is the highest honour a local authority can award. This honour, when accorded to a military unit, is symbolic of the trust the Borough places in the regiment, and endows the privilege for the Corps to march through the Borough with drums beating and bayonets fixed.

Inviting Sir David to sign the Freedom book, the Mayor recalled the strong sense of community displayed by members of the Postal and Courier Depot. They raised money for the Mayor's Appeal and other charities, helped Finchley Old People's Welfare, acted as drivers for John Grooms and supported the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme. The Borough was proud to honour the Corps.

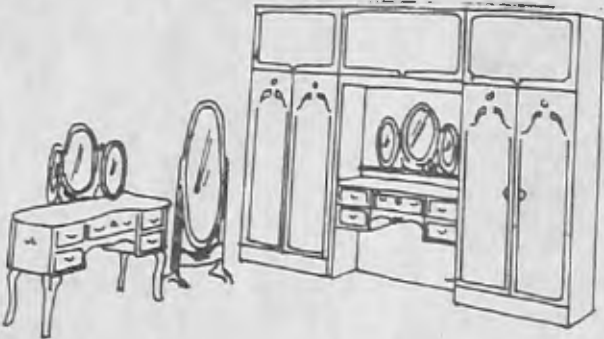

Barnet Civic News is a monthly magazine carrying news of Council activities and local voluntary organisations. For the benefit of advertisers who do not require borough-wide distribution Civic News is now in two editions: A, Barnet and Finchley areas; B, Hendon and Edgware. Each represents a circulation of 55,000 approx. Editorial pages are the same throughout.

HIGHWAY ROUND-UP

The number of abandoned cars being reported to Barnet Council's Borough Engineer and Surveyor's Department has more than doubled in the past year.

In 1981 the average number of complaints was 170 a month. This year it has reached 350.

One of the reasons for the increase is the high cost of buying a car. Many drivers keep their old car on the road until it can no longer pass an MoT test and finally abandon it on the public highway.

For the Council, trying to keep such vehicles off the Borough's streets, the problem is frustrating and time consuming.

If a vehicle is obviously abandoned and derelict a check is made with the Licencing Office at Swansea. Then a notice is fixed to the car giving seven days notice that the vehicle will be towed away.

At the same time enquiries are made in the neighbourhood to try and find the owner. If he or she wants to keep the car they are asked to get the vehicle off the road where it is a safety hazard.

If the owner wants it towed away then there is a charge of £8 for the Council to remove it to Brent Terrace depot. If the owner cannot be traced the Council tows the vehicle away.

There is a greater problem with untaxed cars which are thought to be abandoned but which are not in a derelict condition and still have substantial value.

The Council have to contact the Vehicle Licencing Centre at Swansea to trace the registered owner. This has to be done by formal letter and it can be three or four weeks before a reply is received.

The owner is then contacted and informed that unless the vehicle is removed it will be towed away.

If no reply is received the vehicle is removed and held at Brent Terrace for 21 days, when, if it has not been claimed, it is destroyed.

In all cases the police are notified to make sure that the vehicle is not subject to police enquiries.

Owners who have a car they wish to get rid of can write to the Borough Engineer and Surveyor, Gateway House, 322 Regents Park Road, Finchley, N3, enclosing the registration document and a cheque for

£8 made out to Barnet Borough Council with a request for the vehicle to be towed away.

If the car can still be driven and is properly insured, it can be driven by the owner to the GLC depot at Brent Terrace. There is no need for any car to be abandoned on the highway where it attracts children as a highly dangerous playground and often causes a traffic hazard.

The Council are often requested to take action over cars which display no tax disc. This is a police matter and the public should contact their local police station.

Since Barnet Council adopted a tougher attitude to pavement parkers in April 1980, 331 cases have been reported to the Council's legal section for action.

The policy to take direct action against motorists who park on pavements and obstruct pedestrians, has proved successful in many local roads where the pavement parking was particularly blatant.

If your car has a 'Vroom Vroom' sound when you press the accelerator, or your motorcycle sounds as if it was tuned for the Isle of Man TT then you are probably breaking the law.

And if your neighbour's car sounds the same and is threatening to damage your eardrums, he too is breaking the law.

There are regulations which lay down the amount of noise a car, motorcycle or any other road vehicle can make. And far too many are over the top of the level laid down. It is a similar story with exhaust fumes.

Concerned by the nuisance caused by noisy vehicles and vapour fumes in the borough Barnet Council's Public Works Committee have asked the local police to take a tougher line with offenders.

At the same time they are raising the matter with the Association of Metropolitan Authorities and the London Borough's Association to ask them to investigate whether there could be a strengthening or tightening up of legislation.

BARNET WINS TROPHY

THE Borough of Barnet have won their class in the National Allotments Competition which is organised annually by the National Society of Leisure Gardeners Limited. Last year Barnet were third.

Our picture shows Cllr. Mrs Shirley More, last year's chairman of Barnet Council's Allotments Committee, receiving the Bledisloe Trophy from Mr H. E. Robinson, president of the society.

The society assess interest, assistance and encouragement given by local authorities to plot holders and leisure gardeners.

There are three classes in the competition and for some years Barnet have competed for the Bledisloe Cup for authorities with a population of 200,000 or more.

A day in the life of ... A HOME HELP

WEDNESDAY, July 7, was the day Civic News joined the Home Help service. And after five hours of scrubbing floors, doing the laundry, cleaning baths and fireplaces this editor returned thankfully to the typewriter, singing the praises of the gallant band of women — and a few men — who every day carry out this work in the homes of the borough's frail, elderly and disabled.

From personal experience let me say 'They are doing a wonderful job.'

The day started at 9 am when, in company with Home Help Jean Pacelli, we called at a house in North Finchley, to start the morning's work.

A world of her own

It would be wrong in an article like this to identify the clients of Barnet Council's Home Help Service, so we shall call this first lady we visited Beth.

Beth is a darling but she lives in a world of 60 years ago when she was in her twenties and her mother was alive.

She spends most days at a day centre, but before she can go she has to be washed and dressed because sadly she is incontinent.

So Jean's first job is to bathe and dress her. Then the laundry has to be tackled — washed by hand because it is not suitable for a washing machine.

It must be ten years since I had tackled a sinkful of hand washing and it was hard and not very pleasant work.

Jean took the opportunity of having a junior assistant to give our client's room an extra good clean, and then went round with the vacuum cleaner and coped with the bathroom.

Beth's son lives at home, disabled by the effects of polio. He

makes a marvellous job of the garden and copes very well with some of the household chores. But he was very worried about a fall of soot from the chimney in the dining room, brought down by the torrential rains earlier in the month.

Cleaning up that soot was no joke. But wearing the overall supplied by the Home Help Service, and protected by rubber gloves, we managed to wrap the piles of soot in newspaper and get the grate back to working order.

Chat about problems

A quick cup of coffee, a chat about some problems he was having with his request for a rates rebate, and a session of peeling potatoes for the next three days, and we were off to our next point of call.

Nothing could have presented a greater contrast from the old, somewhat inconvenient house to the bright modern council flat that was the home of one of the bravest women I have ever met.

In recent years she has been in and out of hospital and has had a series of major operations and radio therapy. She is in pain, she can only walk for short distances, but her home was a delight to enter — everything was clean and tidy, with pictures of her daughter, grandchildren and great-granddaughter bringing life to the home.

A cheering visit

May manages her own light cleaning so all we had to do here was the kitchen floor and the bathroom. But having a chat over the coffee break was perhaps the most important part of Jean's contribution to her client's welfare. Often she runs May over to the Post Office, and on this day she took her to her sister's house because in

spite of all her own health problems, May was worried about her sister who had not been well and whose daughter was away on holiday.

I think the visit to May cheered Jean and I up and set us on our way to our next port of call.

This call was to a large house where, because of failing health, the elderly couple are no longer able to manage the cleaning for themselves.

The lady of the house had been upset by the very hot weather and was resting but she had tried to cope with some of the housework and now directed Jean on the cleaning of bathrooms and brushing of hall mats.

By now it was quarter to two and with another engagement for the afternoon I had to leave Jean still manfully working.

I felt I had done a week's work in a morning, and the houses we left were far cleaner than my own which gets a mop over the kitchen floor once a week.

But Jean seemed as fresh as when she started. 'Pity you can't come tomorrow,' she said, 'I've got one of my favourites. He suffers with Huntingdon's Chorea and so I do the shopping and cook meals for a few days because he goes to a day centre and needs something for the evening meal.'

I went back to work after a quick shower at home and a change of clothes, wanting to tell the world about the wonderful job our Home Helps are doing.

A charge is made for the service. People on supplementary benefit and on low incomes pay £1 a week, irrespective of how many hours are worked. For the better off the fee is graduated to a maximum of £2.45 an hour. The

service is allocated according to need and not ability to pay, and for the past two years Barnet Council has waived the minimum fee during winter months.

The Home Helps themselves receive about £1.77 an hour. They are provided with overalls and gloves, and where necessary cleaning materials. They have to make their own way to the first client but after that bus fares are paid to get from one client to the next, and travelling time is allowed for in their hours of work.

Hours of service

In the Borough there are more than 300 Home Helps who between them give about 6,000 hours of service every week.

At present they are organised from the six Area Team offices but in the Autumn there is to be a complete restructuring of the Social Services organisation.

The Home Helps, Home Makers and Home Care Service will be grouped into the Domiciliary Service which will be organised from three centres — the Area Team offices at East Barnet Town Hall, Station Road, New Barnet, Herts.; Barnard House, Burnt Oak Broadway, Edgware, Middlesex; and Park House, 16 High Road, East Finchley.

As at present the Home Help organisers will continue to be responsible for assessing whether local residents should receive the Meals on Wheels Service.

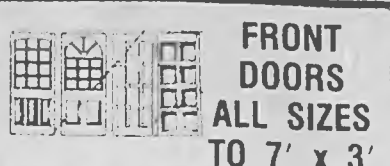

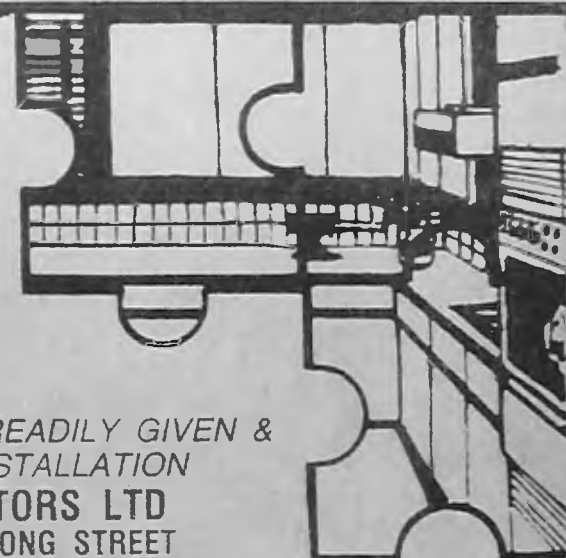
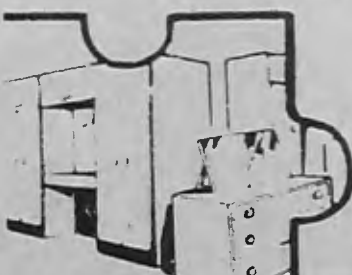

The chance to judge came when an exhibition of work was staged in the Old Bull Centre, High Street, Barnet, from July 5 to 10.

Hand-printed designs on cushions, shopping bags and T-shirts, paintings, pottery, poetry and collages made from the products of the throw-away society, such as egg boxes and plastic cups, made a cheerful showing at the Centre.

Fieldways on parade

It is the first time Fieldways have staged a full-scale exhibition although they have had displays in a bank window and at Barnet Hospital.

Mrs. Win Harris, centre manager, was delighted with the result. 'The Old Bull Centre have been very good to us, allowing us to use this exhibition room and I think our students have excelled themselves this year.'

Fieldways caters for 40 students who have some form of

mental handicap. Here adult students are taught social and domestic skills and take part in further education programmes, work experience and recreation and leisure pursuits.

The centre provides a secure and stimulating environment which allows the students to develop their abilities and maximise the skills that they possess.

It provides the means for a mentally handicapped student to become as independent as possible by learning very basic

skills of ordinary life to the stage when a student can move from the centre to open employment.

It helps students to mature emotionally and develop social relationships, teaches them to use leisure time constructively, offers support and advice to both the students and their families, and provides those who attend with opportunities to make a positive contribution to society.

Fieldways is at Wellhouse Lane, Barnet, and there are other similar centres in other areas of the borough.

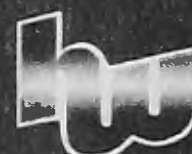

STC SPONSOR BARNET STUDENTS

The STC Award scheme, administered by Barnet's Education Department, is for local sixth formers who are going to university to study electrical or electronic engineering. To qualify the students have to reside in the borough, have a score of nine in their 'A' levels and have been accepted on a full-time degree course in an appropriate subject.

Last year eight students gained awards, which are issued as a series of £300 yearly grants. Six were able to accept an invitation to visit STC's site at New Southgate.

Welcoming the undergraduates, Mr. John Barker, manager of manufacturing operations, said that even in these days of high unemployment it was difficult to recruit young scientists and engineers with the qualifica-

tions industry needed. The field of electronic communications was a fast-changing business and needed educated, lively and flexible people to develop the communications systems of tomorrow. There was an imbalance between the arts and the technical courses and it was

through schemes such as the STC Awards that industry hoped to encourage young people to study the technical sciences.

The Mayor, reminding his audience that he had spent three years as chairman of Middlesex Polytechnic, said the Borough

of Barnet was very conscious of the need for education to be widely based and to reflect the needs of employers and students.

Among those present at the reception was Mr. Jack Dawkins, Director of Education Services for the Borough.

Mobile rights campaign success

BETWEEN 200 and 300 people visited Barnet's Mobile Welfare Advice Campaign, which toured the Borough from June 14 to 19. Many had interviews with the staff manning the mobile office, others took leaflets.

The unit was manned by staff from Barnet Council's Social Services Department, the Government's Department of Health and Social Security, local Citizens' Advice Bureaux and DABB (Disablement Association for the Borough of Barnet). Representatives of the Citizens' Rights Group and National Federation of Pensioners also contributed.

Lost rights

Mr. Alan Gorst, Director of Social Services for the Borough of Barnet, explained: 'The need for potential recipients to claim money to which their insurance payments and taxes have entitled them is continuous. With rising unemployment, the increasing number of elderly and handicapped persons and the still complicated social security system, more people may be losing much-needed money. Being without can result in people saving on basic food, heating

and clothing and may endanger health and damage pride.

'Obviously handicapped people cannot be reached by such a campaign, nor can a mobile campaign for a single week in the year solve the problem of non take-up of welfare rights.'

A record of enquiries showed that about 175 people made specific enquiries, sometimes on several needs. For instance, a pensioner may also need advice on payments for handicapped persons or have a need for a social services assessment for aids or house adaptations. The most enquiries, 47, were recorded on the Saturday morning session at Burnt Oak Broadway. The second highest number of contacts was made when the van was near the Finchley Post Office, and in East Finchley, 30 each.

Business was slowest on a rainy afternoon by Tally Ho Gaumont. The sessions at Chipping Barnet car park were also less busy.

Most queries focused on disability and housing problems, with pensions, supplementary benefit, health and rent/rebate problems coming next. Some questions were asked about unemployment benefits and facilities, including the local author-

ity's scheme for reduced admission fees to places of recreation and sport, free legal aid and social services, particularly about aids for physically handicapped people.

There were few enquiries about the family income supplement for those with a working parent or parents.

Some people offered to work as volunteers and one or two offered us money — not taken!

Help given

Most referrals were made to the DHSS, 24; and the Citizens' Advice Bureaux, 21. Others were made to Social Services, Trading Standards, East Finchley Neighbourhood Centre, the Volunteer Bureau and National Federation of Pensioners and to the local authority Treasurer's department for rate or rent rebates.

'We were visited by people from other authorities who did not have such campaigns, by one or two Councillors and by one person who thought it would achieve nothing!

'We hope to repeat the Campaign in the future. Certainly the efforts of the participating agencies were widely appreciated,' Mr. Gorst said.

FREE LEGAL ADVICE

THE BARNET Law Centre Steering Group will be holding free legal advice sessions on Tuesday, July 20 and every subsequent Tuesday from 7.30 to 9 pm at Barnard House, Burnt Oak Broadway, Edgware, Middlesex.

At these sessions there will be specialist advisers in topics such as Housing, Employment Law, Family Law, Immigration, Welfare Benefits and Discrimination.

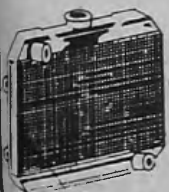

New life for a grand old Finchley oak tree

The great oak in the grounds of Avenue House, which had to be felled last November because of decay will return to Avenue House — as a book case. The Finchley Society wished to establish a memorial to the late Alderman Alfred Pike, former Mayor of Finchley, to recognise his work for the Society and for Finchley. When the oak had to be felled they asked Barnet Council if they could use the timber and have a cabinet maker design a memorial book case. The planks from the tree will be air dried and cured for six months to a year. Those identified for the book case will

be kiln dried but the rest of the planks will be air dried for several years before being used. The book case itself will be placed in Avenue House where the Finchley Society meets.

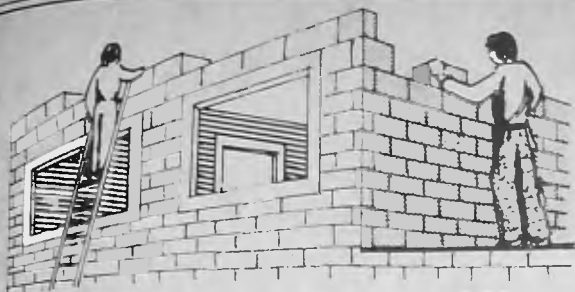

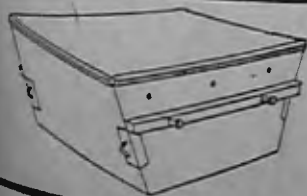

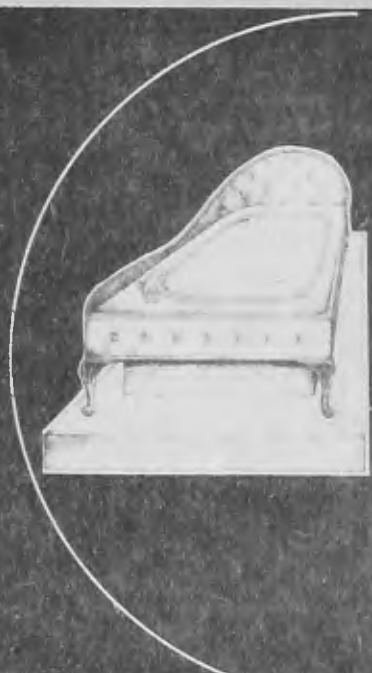
